| 9 | (1) Sergeant Robert Eugene Goodlin grew up in Commodore, |
| 10 | Indiana County, and attended Purchase Line High School. |
| 11 | (2) During the Vietnam Conflict, Sgt. Goodlin served in |
| 12 | the United States Army as a sergeant with Company B, 2nd |
| 13 | Battalion, 50th Infantry, 2nd Armored Division. |
| 14 | (3) Among his decorations, Sgt. Goodlin was awarded the |
| 15 | Bronze Star Medal and the Vietnam Service Medal with two |
| 16 | Bronze Service Stars. |

(b) Designation.--The bridge located on State Route 1012,
known as the Diamondville Bridge, Cherryhill Township, Indiana
County, is designated the Sgt. Robert Eugene Goodlin Memorial
Bridge.

5 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and 6 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to 7 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
