- Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
 Consolidated Statutes, in veterans' pensions and benefits,
 further providing for blind veteran's pension and for amputee
 and paralyzed veteran's pension.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Sections 7701(b) and 7702(a) of Title 51 of the
- 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 9 § 7701. Blind veteran's pension.
- 10 * * *
- 11 (b) Amount and eligibility. -- In addition to any other
- 12 assistance provided by the Commonwealth and in addition to any
- 13 compensation provided by the Federal Government, every blind
- 14 veteran shall be paid a pension of [\$150] $\frac{$200}{}$ \$250 per month. <--
- 15 Applications for such pensions shall be made to and in the form
- 16 prescribed by the department. The Adjutant General shall have
- 17 the power, and it shall be his duty to determine the eligibility

- 1 of every applicant for a pension, and his decision in the matter
- 2 shall be final. THE AMOUNT OF THE PENSION SHALL BE INCREASED
- 3 BIENNIALLY, ON JANUARY 1, BY THE PERCENTAGE CHANGE INCREASE, IF
- 4 ANY, IN THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX FOR ALL URBAN CONSUMERS (CPI-U)
- 5 FOR THE PENNSYLVANIA, NEW JERSEY, DELAWARE AND MARYLAND AREA FOR
- 6 THE MOST RECENT 12-MONTH PERIOD FOR WHICH FIGURES ARE OFFICIALLY
- 7 REPORTED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, BUREAU OF
- 8 <u>LABOR STATISTICS. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSMIT NOTICE OF ANY</u>
- 9 BIENNIAL INCREASE TO THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU FOR
- 10 PUBLICATION IN THE PENNSYLVANIA BULLETIN.
- 11 § 7702. Amputee and paralyzed veteran's pension.
- 12 (a) Amount and eligibility. -- In addition to any other
- 13 assistance provided by the Commonwealth and in addition to any
- 14 compensation provided by the Federal Government, every amputee
- 15 and paralyzed veteran shall be paid a pension of [\$150] \$\frac{\$200}{} <-
- 16 $\frac{$250}{}$ per month. Applications for the pensions shall be made to <--
- 17 and in the form prescribed by the department. The Adjutant
- 18 General shall determine the eligibility of every applicant for a
- 19 pension, and his decision in the matter shall be final. THE <-
- 20 AMOUNT OF THE PENSION SHALL BE INCREASED BIENNIALLY, ON JANUARY
- 21 1, BY THE PERCENTAGE CHANGE INCREASE, IF ANY, IN THE CONSUMER
- 22 PRICE INDEX FOR ALL URBAN CONSUMERS (CPI-U) FOR THE
- 23 PENNSYLVANIA, NEW JERSEY, DELAWARE AND MARYLAND AREA FOR THE
- 24 MOST RECENT 12-MONTH PERIOD FOR WHICH FIGURES ARE OFFICIALLY
- 25 REPORTED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, BUREAU OF
- 26 LABOR STATISTICS. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSMIT NOTICE OF ANY
- 27 <u>BIENNIAL INCREASE TO THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU FOR</u>
- 28 PUBLICATION IN THE PENNSYLVANIA BULLETIN.

- 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
