- Amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania
 Consolidated Statutes, in lobbying disclosure, further
 providing for definitions and for prohibited activities.

 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 hereby enacts as follows:

 Section 1. Section 13A03 of Title 65 of the Pennsylvania

 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:

- "Campaign consultant." A person that receives compensation
- 14 for campaign-related professional services rendered to a

- 17 Section 2. Section 13A07(f)(1) of Title 65 is amended by
- 18 adding a subparagraph to read:

1 § 13A07. Prohibited activities.

3 (f) Unlawful acts.--

4 (1) A lobbyist or principal may not:

5 * * *

6 (xi) Engage in lobbying a State official or a State employee on the State official's staff after serving as a 7 campaign consultant for the State official or after 8 9 having a pecuniary interest in a campaign consultant that rendered campaign consulting services for the State 10 official. This prohibition shall only apply for the term 11 in which the State official was elected and for which the 12 campaign consulting services were provided. 13
