(A) A record containing all or part of a 4 5 person's Social Security number, driver's license 6 number, personal financial information, home, 7 cellular or personal telephone numbers, home address, 8 personal e-mail addresses, employee number or other 9 confidential personal identification number. A spouse's name, marital status or 10 (B) 11 beneficiary or dependent information. 12 [(C) The home address of a law enforcement officer or judge.] 13 14 Nothing in this paragraph shall preclude the (ii) 15 release of the name, position, salary, actual 16 compensation or other payments or expenses, employment 17 contract, employment-related contract or agreement and 18 length of service of a public official or an agency 19 employee. 20 An agency may redact the name or other (iii) 21 identifying information relating to an individual 22 performing an undercover or covert law enforcement 23 activity from a record. * * * 24
