AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative 4 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 5 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 7 8 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 12 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; providing for the regulation of pari-mutuel 17 thoroughbred horse racing and harness horse racing 18 19 activities, imposing certain taxes and providing for the 20 disposition of funds from pari-mutuel tickets; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation 21 of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of 22 certain departments, boards and commissions shall be 23 determined," in Commonwealth budget procedures, providing for 24 general appropriation bill compensation suspension. 25 26 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 27 hereby enacts as follows: 28 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known
- 29 as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding a

- 2 <u>Section 613.1. General Appropriation Bill Compensation</u>
- 3 Suspension.--If the General Assembly fails to pass or the
- 4 Governor fails to sign a general appropriation bill for a fiscal
- 5 <u>year or the Governor fails to sign the final revenue estimate</u>
- 6 for a fiscal year, compensation for the Governor, Lieutenant
- 7 Governor, cabinet officers and members of the General Assembly
- 8 <u>shall be suspended until a general appropriation bill has been</u>
- 9 passed by the General Assembly and signed by the Governor or the
- 10 final revenue estimate is signed by the Governor.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
