## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), entitled "An act to promote the public health and safety by providing for 2 examination, licensing and granting of permits for those who 3 desire to engage in the profession of cosmetology; defining 4 cosmetology, and regulating cosmetology salons, schools, 5 students, apprentices, teachers, managers, manicurists and 6 cosmetologists; conferring powers and duties upon the Commissioner of Professional and Occupational Affairs of the 7 8 Department of State; providing for appeals to certain courts 9 by applicants and licensees; and providing penalties," 10 11 further providing for definitions. 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The definition of "esthetics" in section 1 of the 14 15 act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), referred to as the 16 Cosmetology Law, is amended and the section is amended by adding definitions to read: 17 Section 1. Definitions .-- The following words and phrases 18 19 when used in this act shall have the meanings given to them in 20 this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: \* \* \* 21 22 "Esthetics" means the practice of massaging the face,

applying cosmetic preparations, antiseptics, tonics, lotions or

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- 1 creams to the face, removing superfluous hair by tweezers,
- 2 depilatories or waxes [and], the dyeing of eyelashes and
- 3 eyebrows and performing mechanical exfoliation and
- 4 <u>microneedling</u>.

- 6 <u>"Mechanical exfoliation" means the physical removal of</u>
- 7 surface epidermal cells by means that include, but are not
- 8 limited to, brushing machines, granulated scrubs, peel-off
- 9 masques, peeling creams or drying preparations that are rubbed
- 10 off and microdermabrasion.
- 11 "Microdermabrasion" means mechanical exfoliation using an
- 12 <u>abrasive material or apparatus to remove surface epidermal cells</u>
- 13 <u>with a machine.</u>
- 14 <u>"Microneedling" means the use of multiple tiny solid needles</u>
- 15 <u>designed to pierce the skin for the purpose of stimulating</u>
- 16 <u>collagen production or cellular renewal.</u>

- 18 Section 2. The State Board of Cosmetology shall promulgate
- 19 regulations required to implement this act within 18 months of
- 20 the effective date of this section.
- 21 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
