AN ACT

1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for eligibility for license.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Section 2704 of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
6 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:

7 § 2704. Eligibility for license.

8 * * *

9 (g) Hunter education in public schools.--Upon request of the
10 commission, all public school districts in this Commonwealth
11 shall make a school facility under their control available for
12 the purpose of conducting a hunter education course. Classes may
13 occur either during the school day or as an after-school OR <--
14 WEEKEND function. After school or evening classes shall be made <--
15 available to the public as a community service. THE COMMISSION <--
16 SHALL TO THE BEST OF ITS ABILITY WORK WITH THE SCHOOL TO

1 SCHEDULE CLASSES FOR A TIME THAT BEST SUITS BOTH THE SCHOOL AND
2 THE COMMISSION. All classes shall comply with curriculum
3 standards and program policies established by the director. No <--
4 costs shall be incurred by the commission for use of the
5 facility, nor shall any fees be charged to the public for the
6 service under this subsection. THE COMMISSION SHALL COMPENSATE <--
7 THE SCHOOL FOR THE ACTUAL COST INCURRED BY THE SCHOOL RELATED TO
8 THE COMMISSION'S USE OF THE FACILITY. NO FEES MAY BE CHARGED TO
9 THE PUBLIC FOR THE SERVICE UNDER THIS SECTION.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
