Section 1605.1(c) of the act of March 10, 1949 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection to 11 12 read: 13 Section 1605.1. Assessment of Civic Knowledge. --* * * 14 (a.1) Beginning in the 2024-2025 school year and each year 15 thereafter, in order to graduate from high school or obtain a 16 general equivalency diploma, a student shall correctly answer at 17 least sixty per centum (60%) of the questions on the assessment under subsection (a) (1). 18
