AN ACT

- Amending Title 4 (Amusements) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in revenues, further providing for transfers from
- 3 State Gaming Fund.

- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1408(c) of Title 4 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1408. Transfers from State Gaming Fund.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (c) Local law enforcement grants. -- Except as provided in
- 11 subsection (c.1), annually, the sum of \$2,000,000 shall be
- 12 transferred to the board for the purpose of issuing grants to
- 13 local law enforcement agencies to investigate violations of and
- 14 enforce laws relating to unlawful gambling in this Commonwealth.
- 15 [For purposes of this subsection, the term "local law
- 16 enforcement agency"] The following shall apply:
- 17 (1) As used in this subsection, the following words and
- 18 phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this

1 paragraph:

- "Local law enforcement agency." The term shall include 2 3 the Pennsylvania State Police when conducting unlawful 4 gambling enforcement and prevention activities in a municipality which does not have a municipal police 5 6 department and in which the Pennsylvania State Police provide 7 the municipality with primary police coverage.
- "Unlawful gambling." The term shall include an offense 8 9 under 18 Pa.C.S. §§ 5513 (relating to gambling devices, gambling, etc.), 5543 (relating to animal fighting) and 5544 10 (relating to possession of animal fighting paraphernalia). 11 (2) (Reserved). 12
