## AN ACT

- Designating the Eastern Timber Rattlesnake as the Official Reptile of this Commonwealth.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Eastern Timber Rattlesnake (Crotalus horridus
- 4 horridus) is a large and venomous snake known to reach lengths
- 5 of over 55 inches in this Commonwealth; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Timber rattlesnakes have been recorded in 53 of
- 7 Pennsylvania's 67 counties, from the Pocono Plateau of the
- 8 northeast, the Appalachian range from the southcentral counties
- 9 through the northcentral and northeastern counties, the
- 10 Allegheny Plateau of the northwest and the Laurel Highlands in
- 11 the southwest; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The snake prefers higher-elevation woodlands with a
- 13 diversity of habitat types, including stream corridors,
- 14 blueberry thickets, rocky outcrops, reverting clear cuts, open
- 15 meadows and utility rights-of-way.
- 16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 17 hereby enacts as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Official State Reptile.
- 2 The Eastern Timber Rattlesnake is selected, designated and
- 3 adopted as the official reptile of the Commonwealth of
- 4 Pennsylvania.
- 5 Section 2. Effective date.
- 6 This act shall take effect immediately.
