AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in charter schools, providing for full-time cyber education program offered by school district. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1723.1-A. Full-time Cyber Education Program Offered
- by School District. -- (a) Notwithstanding section 1725-A(a)(1) 13
- or any other provision of law to the contrary, the following
- shall apply to a student who resides in a school district that 15
- 16 offers a full-time cyber education program:
- 17 (1) If the student enrolls in the full-time cyber education
- 18 program offered by the school district of residence, the
- student's enrollment in the cyber education program shall be 19

- 1 subject to no tuition or fees other than fees that the school
- 2 <u>district imposes on its students generally.</u>
- 3 (2) If the student chooses to enroll in a cyber charter
- 4 school, the student or the student's parent or guardian shall be
- 5 responsible to pay the cyber charter school a per-student amount
- 6 <u>calculated in the manner provided under section 1725-A(a)(2) and</u>
- 7 (3). The payments shall be made to the cyber charter school in
- 8 twelve (12) equal monthly payments, by the fifth day of each
- 9 month, within the operating school year. A student enrolled in a
- 10 cyber charter school under this clause shall not be included in
- 11 the average daily membership of the student's school district of
- 12 <u>residence for the purpose of providing basic education funding</u>
- 13 payments and special education funding under Article XXV.
- (b) As used in this section, the term "full-time cyber
- 15 <u>education program" shall mean a complete course of study that is</u>
- 16 offered by a school district in which the school district uses
- 17 technology in order to provide a significant portion of its
- 18 curriculum and to deliver a significant portion of instruction
- 19 to its students through the Internet or other electronic means
- 20 and that is not a cyber charter school established under section
- 21 1745-A.
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
