10	Section 1. Section 701.1 of Title 8 of the Pennsylvania

12	§ 701.1. Authorization and expenses.
13	(a) DelegatesCouncil may, by motion, designate one or
14	more delegates from the elected or appointed officers or newly
15	elected officers prior to officially taking office of the
16	borough to attend the annual meeting of the State Association of
17	Boroughs, which shall be held in this Commonwealth in accordance
18	with the procedure adopted by the State Association of Boroughs.
19	(b) NondelegatesCouncil may, by motion, designate one or
20	more elected or appointed officers or newly elected officers

prior to officially taking office or employees of the borough to 1 2 attend the annual meeting of the State Association of Boroughs 3 as nondelegates or to attend a conference, educational training or committee meeting of the State Association of Boroughs. 4 5 (c) Expenses.--The following shall apply: 6 In addition to any compensation allowed under (1)7 section 701.2 (relating to compensation), council may, for 8 each delegate, elected or appointed officer or newly elected 9 officer prior to officially taking office or employee under 10 subsection (a) or (b), pay the following expenses upon receipt of an itemized account of expenses: 11 12 (i) The registration fee. 13 (ii) Mileage for use of a personal vehicle or 14 reimbursement of actual transportation expenses going to 15 and returning from the annual meeting, conference, 16 educational training or committee meeting of the State 17 Association of Boroughs. 18 (iii) Any actual expenses that the council may have 19 agreed to pay. 20 Notwithstanding this subsection, at least one member (2)21 of council shall be allowed the following expenses: 22 The registration fee. (i) 23 (ii) Lodging, meals and mileage for use of a 24 personal vehicle or reimbursement of actual 25 transportation expenses going to and returning from the 26 meeting. 27 Any actual expenses that the council may have (iii) 28 agreed to pay. 29 Section 2. Section 10916(a)(2) and (3), (b) and (c) of Title 11 are amended to read: 30

5	(2) form and organize a <u>municipal</u> league [of cities and
6	municipalities]; and
7	(3) hold [annual conventions] <u>conferences, educational</u>
8	trainings and meetings for the study and consideration of
9	municipal affairs [of concern that pertain to the cities and
10	municipalities comprising the league].
11	(b) [Delegates] <u>Officials and expenses</u> A city [that is a
12	member of the league] may [do the following]:
13	(1) Send [delegates to the league.] officials to the
14	league's conferences, educational trainings and meetings.
15	Newly elected or appointed officials prior to officially
16	taking office may attend the league's conferences,
17	educational trainings and meetings.
18	(2) Pay the necessary expenses[, including:
19	(i) Incidental expenses to attend the annual
20	convention.
21	(ii) Dues to the league.] of those attending the
22	league's conferences, educational trainings and meetings,
23	including incidental expenses.
24	(3) Appropriate money for dues to the league.
25	[(iii)] (4) Appropriate money to join and
26	participate in any of the various business and training
27	programs of the league designed to address municipal
28	needs in a cost-efficient manner.
29	[(3)] <u>(5)</u> Provide a fund for the necessary costs and
30	expenses of <u>participation in</u> the league [and league

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1 conventions].

2 (c) Accounting.--Each [delegate] <u>official</u> shall submit to 3 the city controller for approval an itemized account of the 4 [delegate's] <u>official's</u> expenses to be paid under the authority 5 of this section.

7 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
