Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for chemical testing in accidents involving death or personal injury. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 3742 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: 7 § 3742. Accidents involving death or personal injury. 8 * * * 9 10 (a.1) Driving under the influence of alcohol or controlled 11 substance. -- The following shall apply: 12 (1) A law enforcement official shall obtain a chemical 13 test sample for any driver of a vehicle involved in an 14 accident resulting in serious bodily injury or death of any 15 person. 16 (2) Once the results of the test obtained under 17 paragraph (1) are completed, medical personnel who administered the testing shall immediately provide the 18

- 3 violation of this subsection for any failure to comply with

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
