AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for 2 definitions; in special vehicles and pedestrians, providing 3 for operation of kei class light-duty trucks; and, in 4 inspection of vehicles, further providing for operation of 5 vehicle without official certificate of inspection. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 102 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read: 10 § 102. Definitions. 11 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent 12 13 provisions of this title which are applicable to specific provisions of this title, the following words and phrases when 14 used in this title shall have, unless the context clearly 15 indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section: 16 * * * 17 18 "Kei class light-duty truck." A four-wheeled, fuel-powered vehicle that has a maximum design speed of not more than 45

- miles per hour and that is certified by the manufacturer to 20

- 2 established in 49 CFR 571.500 (relating to Standard No. 500;

- 17 § 3598. Scope of subchapter.
- 18 This subchapter applies to the operation of kei class light-
- 19 duty trucks on certain highways or roadways in this
- 20 <u>Commonwealth</u>.
- 21 § 3598.1. Required equipment.
- 22 (a) General rule. -- A kei class light-duty truck operated
- 23 upon a highway or roadway in this Commonwealth shall be
- 24 <u>maintained in proper condition and comply with the equipment</u>
- 25 requirements and standards as set forth in 49 CFR 571.500
- 26 (relating to Standard No. 500; Low-speed vehicles). A kei class
- 27 light-duty truck operated upon a highway or roadway in this
- 28 Commonwealth shall be equipped with the following additional
- 29 equipment:
- 30 (1) Brakes adequate to control the movement of and to

- 1 <u>stop the vehicle.</u>
- 2 (2) An odometer.
- 3 <u>(3) A speedometer.</u>
- 4 (4) The original manufacturer's vehicle identification
- 5 <u>number die stamped upon the body or frame, or both, of the</u>
- 6 <u>vehicle or the original manufacturer's vehicle identification</u>
- 7 <u>number die stamped upon the engine or motor of the vehicle.</u>
- 8 (b) Exemption. -- A kei class light-duty truck shall be exempt
- 9 from equipment requirements not enumerated in this subchapter.
- 10 (c) Slow moving vehicle emblem. -- A kei class light-duty
- 11 truck shall have a slow moving vehicle emblem affixed in a
- 12 conspicuous place on the rear of the vehicle consistent with the
- 13 provisions of section 4529 (relating to slow moving vehicle
- 14 emblem).
- 15 (d) Penalties. -- A person who operates a kei class light-duty
- 16 truck without the equipment prescribed in this section shall be
- 17 subject to the penalties under section 6502 (relating to summary
- 18 offenses).
- 19 § 3598.2. Operation on certain highways or roadways.
- 20 (a) Operation on State highways.--
- 21 (1) Except as otherwise provided under paragraphs (2)
- and (3), a kei class light-duty truck may not be operated
- 23 upon a highway or roadway under the jurisdiction of the
- department with a posted speed in excess of 45 miles per
- 25 hour.
- 26 (2) The secretary may, by order, permit the use of a kei
- 27 class light-duty truck upon a highway or roadway under the
- 28 jurisdiction of the department where the posted speed limit
- 29 is greater than 25 miles per hour but not greater than 45
- 30 miles per hour.

1	(3) The secretary may, by order, prohibit the use of a
2	kei class light-duty truck on a street under the jurisdiction
3	of the department where the secretary determines that the
4	operation of a kei class light-duty truck would constitute a
5	hazard.
6	(4) An order issued by the secretary under paragraph (2)
7	or (3) shall be published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
8	(b) Operation on local roadways
9	(1) A kei class light-duty truck may not be operated
10	upon a highway or roadway under the jurisdiction of a local
11	authority with a posted speed limit in excess of 55 miles per
12	hour.
13	(2) A local authority may, by ordinance or resolution,
14	on a roadway under the local authority's jurisdiction, permit
15	the use of a kei class light-duty truck where the posted
16	speed limit is greater than 25 miles per hour but not greater
17	than 55 miles per hour.
18	(3) A local authority may, by ordinance or resolution,
19	on a roadway under the local authority's jurisdiction,
20	prohibit the use of a kei class light-duty truck on a roadway
21	where the local authority determines that the operation of a
22	kei class light-duty truck would constitute a hazard.
23	(c) Intersection with State highways
24	(1) A kei class light-duty truck may enter an
25	intersection and cross a highway or roadway under the
26	jurisdiction of the department where the posted speed limit
27	is 35 miles per hour or less. If the highway or roadway is
28	more than two lanes or is divided, crossing shall only occur
29	at a signalized intersection or at a nonsignalized
30	intersection that the secretary determines to be appropriate

- for crossings, either on the secretary's own motion or at the
- 2 request of a local authority.
- 3 (2) A kei class light-duty truck may enter an
- 4 <u>intersection and cross a highway or roadway under the</u>
- 5 jurisdiction of the department where the posted speed limit
- is in excess of 35 miles per hour only at a signalized
- 7 <u>intersection or at a nonsignalized intersection that the</u>
- 8 <u>secretary determines to be appropriate for crossing, either</u>
- 9 <u>upon the secretary's own motion or at the request of a local</u>
- 10 authority.
- 11 (d) Intersection with local roadways.--
- 12 <u>(1) A kei class light-duty truck may enter an</u>
- intersection and cross a highway or roadway under the
- jurisdiction of a local authority where the posted speed
- limit is 35 miles per hour or less. If the highway or roadway
- is more than two lanes or is divided, crossing shall only
- 17 occur at a signalized intersection or at a nonsignalized
- intersection that the local authority, by ordinance or
- 19 <u>resolution, as appropriate, determines to be appropriate for</u>
- crossing.
- 21 (2) A kei class light-duty truck may enter an
- 22 intersection and cross a highway or roadway under the
- jurisdiction of a local authority where the posted speed
- 24 <u>limit is in excess of 35 miles per hour only at a signalized</u>
- 25 <u>intersection or at a nonsignalized intersection that the</u>
- local authority, by ordinance or resolution, as appropriate,
- 27 <u>determines to be appropriate for crossing.</u>
- 28 (e) Violation. -- A person operating a kei class light-duty
- 29 truck upon a highway or roadway or crossing a highway or roadway
- 30 in violation of this section shall be subject to the penalties

- 1 <u>under section 6502 (relating to summary offenses).</u>
- 2 § 3598.3. Licensing, financial responsibility, titling and
- 3 registration.
- 4 (a) General rule. -- A kei class light-duty truck shall be
- 5 considered a passenger car for the purposes of Part II (relating
- 6 to title, registration and licensing) and section 4581 (relating
- 7 <u>to restraint systems).</u>
- 8 (b) License and financial responsibility. -- An operator of a
- 9 kei class light-duty truck must have a valid driver's license
- 10 and maintain financial responsibility as required by Chs. 15
- 11 <u>(relating to licensing of drivers) and 17 (relating to financial</u>
- 12 <u>responsibility</u>).
- (c) Certificate of title and registration. -- A kei class
- 14 light-duty truck shall be properly titled and registered with
- 15 the department as required by Chs. 11 (relating to certificate
- 16 of title and security interests) and 13 (relating to
- 17 registration of vehicles). The department shall issue a
- 18 certificate of title upon submission of proof of an original
- 19 export certificate.
- 20 (d) Possession of information. -- The driver's license, the
- 21 registration certificate of a motor vehicle and an insurance
- 22 identification card shall be in the possession of the driver or
- 23 operator at all times when the driver or operator is in charge
- 24 of a kei class light-duty truck on the highways or roadways of
- 25 <u>this Commonwealth.</u>
- 26 § 3598.4. Seating limitation.
- 27 <u>A kei class light-duty truck may not be operated if the</u>
- 28 number of passengers exceeds the number of available safety
- 29 belts in the vehicle.
- 30 § 3598.5. Waiver of liability.

- 1 (a) General rule. -- A purchaser of a new or used kei class
- 2 <u>light-duty truck in this Commonwealth shall execute a waiver and</u>
- 3 certify that the kei class light-duty truck was purchased with
- 4 <u>full knowledge of the potentially hazardous characteristics of</u>
- 5 kei class light-duty trucks as detailed by the manufacturer or
- 6 the manufacturer's agent or dealer.
- 7 (b) Manufacturer responsibility. -- The waiver shall be
- 8 prepared by the manufacturer, agent or dealer and kept in the
- 9 possession of the manufacturer or the manufacturer's agent or
- 10 <u>dealer of kei class light-duty trucks</u>. An executed copy shall be
- 11 provided to the purchaser.
- 12 (c) Signing by purchaser. -- The signing of the waiver by the
- 13 <u>purchaser shall serve to eliminate any liability of the</u>
- 14 manufacturer and the manufacturer's agent or dealer of kei class
- 15 <u>light-duty trucks</u>.
- Section 3. Section 4703(b) of Title 75 is amended by adding
- 17 a paragraph to read:
