AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 37590, carrying  
2 Pennsylvania Route 425 over Fishing Creek, Chanceford  
3 Township, York County, as the PFC James Joseph Criswell  
4 Memorial Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. PFC James Joseph Criswell Memorial Bridge.

8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as  
9 follows:

10 (1) PFC James Joseph Criswell was born on January 16,  
11 1948, in York, Pennsylvania.

12 (2) PFC Criswell served in the United States Army during  
13 the Vietnam War with the 101st Airborne Division, 2nd  
14 Battalion, 105th Infantry, B Company.

15 (3) PFC Criswell was killed in action on August 28,  
16 1968.

17 (4) PFC Criswell was awarded the Purple Heart for his  
18 service and sacrifice to his country.

1       (b) Designation.--The bridge, identified as Bridge Key  
2 37590, carrying Pennsylvania Route 425 over Fishing Creek,  
3 Chanceford Township, York County, is designated the PFC James  
4 Joseph Criswell Memorial Bridge.

5       (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and  
6 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to  
7 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

8 Section 2. Effective date.

9       This act shall take effect in 60 days.
