AN ACT

Amending the act of October 27, 1955 (P.L.744, No.222), entitled <--1 2 "An act prohibiting certain practices of discrimination because of race, color, religious creed, ancestry, age or national origin by employers, employment agencies, labor organizations and others as herein defined; creating the 5 Pennsylvania Human Relations Commission in the Governor's 6 7 Office; defining its functions, powers and duties; providing for procedure and enforcement; providing for formulation of an educational program to prevent prejudice; providing for 9 judicial review and enforcement and imposing penalties, "-10 11 further providing for definitions. AMENDING THE ACT OF OCTOBER 27, 1955 (P.L.744, NO.222), ENTITLED <--12 "AN ACT PROHIBITING CERTAIN PRACTICES OF DISCRIMINATION BECAUSE OF RACE, COLOR, RELIGIOUS CREED, ANCESTRY, AGE OR 14 NATIONAL ORIGIN BY EMPLOYERS, EMPLOYMENT AGENCIES, LABOR 15 ORGANIZATIONS AND OTHERS AS HEREIN DEFINED; CREATING THE 16 PENNSYLVANIA HUMAN RELATIONS COMMISSION IN THE GOVERNOR'S 17 OFFICE; DEFINING ITS FUNCTIONS, POWERS AND DUTIES; PROVIDING FOR PROCEDURE AND ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING FOR FORMULATION OF 19 AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM TO PREVENT PREJUDICE; PROVIDING FOR 20 JUDICIAL REVIEW AND ENFORCEMENT AND IMPOSING PENALTIES," 21 FURTHER PROVIDING FOR DEFINITIONS. 22

- 1 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 2 hereby enacts as follows:
- 3 Section 1. Section 4 of the act of October 27, 1955
- 4 (P.L.744, No.222), known as the Pennsylvania Human Relations

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- 5 Act, is amended by adding clauses to read:
- 6 Section 4. Definitions. As used in this act unless a
- 7 different meaning clearly appears from the context:
- 8 * * *
- 9 <u>(bb) The term "race" includes traits historically associated</u>
- 10 with race, including hair texture and protective hairstyles.
- 11 (cc) The term "protective hairstyle" includes, but is not
- 12 limited to, such hairstyles as dreads, locs, braids, twists,
- 13 <u>coils, Bantu knots, cornrows and extensions.</u>
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
- 15 SECTION 1. SECTION 4 OF THE ACT OF OCTOBER 27, 1955
- 16 (P.L.744, NO.222), KNOWN AS THE PENNSYLVANIA HUMAN RELATIONS
- 17 ACT, IS AMENDED BY ADDING CLAUSES TO READ:
- 18 SECTION 4. DEFINITIONS. -- AS USED IN THIS ACT UNLESS A
- 19 DIFFERENT MEANING CLEARLY APPEARS FROM THE CONTEXT:
- 20 * * *
- 21 (BB) THE TERM "RACE" INCLUDES TRAITS ASSOCIATED WITH RACE,
- 22 INCLUDING HAIR TEXTURE AND PROTECTIVE HAIRSTYLES. NOTHING IN
- 23 THIS CLAUSE SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT AN EMPLOYER FROM
- 24 ADOPTING AND ENFORCING AN OTHERWISE VALID WORKPLACE HEALTH AND
- 25 SAFETY RULE OR POLICY PROVIDED THE EMPLOYER DEMONSTRATES ALL OF
- 26 THE FOLLOWING:
- 27 (1) WITHOUT THE ADOPTION OF THE RULE OR POLICY IT IS
- 28 REASONABLY CERTAIN THAT THE HEALTH OR SAFETY OF AN EMPLOYE OR
- 29 OTHER MATERIALLY CONNECTED PERSON WILL BE IMPAIRED.
- 30 (2) THE RULE OR POLICY IS ADOPTED FOR NONDISCRIMINATORY

- 1 REASONS.
- 2 (3) THE RULE OR POLICY IS APPLIED EQUALLY AND DOES NOT HAVE
- 3 A DISPROPORTIONATE ADVERSE IMPACT ON A GROUP OF INDIVIDUALS
- 4 BASED ON TRAITS ASSOCIATED WITH RACE.
- 5 (4) THE RULE OR POLICY IS SPECIFICALLY TAILORED TO THE
- 6 APPLICABLE POSITION AND ACTIVITY.
- 7 (CC) THE TERM "PROTECTIVE HAIRSTYLE" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT
- 8 LIMITED TO, SUCH HAIRSTYLES AS LOCS, BRAIDS, TWISTS, COILS,
- 9 BANTU KNOTS, AFROS AND EXTENSIONS.
- 10 SECTION 2. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 60 DAYS.
