## AN ACT

10	Section 1. Section 1205.2(k)(1) of the act of March 10, 1949
11	(P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is

13	Section 1205.2. Program of Continuing Professional and
14	Paraprofessional Education* * *
15	(k) A professional educator who is not employed by a school
16	entity as a professional or temporary professional employe may
17	apply to the department for inactive certification. Inactive
18	certification shall:
19	(1) Suspend the requirements of this section until inactive
20	certification is removed by the department. Upon the removal of

inactive certification, a professional educator shall have the same number of hours of continuing professional education [and the same amount of time in which to complete those hours] as existed for the professional educator at the time inactive certification was granted and shall have a new five-year compliance period to complete the hours. \* \* \*

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
