## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in service and facilities, providing for pipeline safety valves.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Chapter 15 of Title 66 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read:

17	§ 1541. Definitions.
18	The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
19	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

- 1 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 2 <u>"Gas." As defined in 49 CFR 192.3 (relating to definitions).</u>
- 3 "Hazardous liquid." As defined in 49 CFR 195.2 (relating to
- 4 definitions).
- 5 "Shutoff valve." A mechanical device used to control the
- 6 <u>flow of gas or liquid that may be used solely for fully open or</u>
- 7 closed applications, to control the direction of flow or to
- 8 throttle flow or regulate pressure. The term includes a plug
- 9 <u>valve</u>, <u>ball valve</u>, <u>globe valve</u> and <u>gate valve</u>.
- 10 "Transmission." The transportation, other than gathering, of
- 11 gas through a transmission line as that term is defined in 49
- 12 CFR 192.3 or of hazardous liquids through a pipeline as that
- 13 term is defined in 49 CFR 195.2.
- 14 § 1542. Automatic or remote controlled shutoff valves for gas
- 15 <u>transmission pipelines.</u>
- 16 (a) General rule. -- All facilities of a public utility
- 17 engaged in the transmission of gas placed into service after the
- 18 effective date of this section shall have automatic or remote
- 19 controlled shutoff valves installed as provided under this
- 20 section.
- 21 (b) Installation. -- In addition to any other valves installed
- 22 by the public utility, the public utility shall install at least
- 23 one automatic or remote controlled shutoff valve at each
- 24 location required under 49 CFR 192.179 (relating to transmission
- 25 line valves).
- 26 (c) Testing frequency. -- The public utility shall test each
- 27 <u>automatic and remote controlled shutoff valve on an annual</u>
- 28 basis. Records of the testing shall be provided annually to each
- 29 municipality in which the automatic or remote controlled shutoff
- 30 valve is tested.

- 1 (d) Replacement. -- If an automatic or remote controlled
- 2 shutoff valve does not operate properly when tested, the public
- 3 utility shall repair or replace the valve as soon as reasonably
- 4 <u>practicable</u>.
- 5 § 1543. Automatic or remote controlled shutoff valves for
- 6 <u>hazardous liquids transmission pipelines.</u>
- 7 (a) General rule. -- All facilities of a public utility
- 8 engaged in the transmission of hazardous liquids placed into
- 9 <u>service after the effective date of this section shall have</u>
- 10 automatic or remote controlled shutoff valves installed as
- 11 provided under this section.
- 12 (b) Installation. -- In addition to any other valves installed
- 13 by the public utility, the public utility shall install at least
- 14 <u>one automatic or remote controlled shutoff valve at each</u>
- 15 <u>location required under 49 CFR 192.179 (relating to transmission</u>
- 16 line valves).
- 17 (c) Testing frequency. -- The public utility shall test each
- 18 automatic and remote controlled shutoff valve on an annual
- 19 basis. Records of the testing shall be provided annually to each
- 20 municipality in which the automatic or remote controlled shutoff
- 21 valve is tested.
- 22 (d) Replacement.--If an automatic or remote controlled
- 23 shutoff valve does not operate properly when tested, the public
- 24 utility shall repair or replace the valve as soon as reasonably
- 25 practicable.
- 26 <u>§ 1544. Penalties.</u>
- The commission may, after notice and opportunity to be heard,
- 28 impose civil penalties under section 3301 (relating to civil
- 29 penalties for violations) and other appropriate remedies for
- 30 violations of this subchapter and the regulations and orders of

- 1 the commission.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
