AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," providing for COVID-19 school 5 employee bonus. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 9 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding an 10 11 article to read: 12 ARTICLE XXVI-L 13 COVID-19 SCHOOL EMPLOYEE BONUS 14 Section 2601-L. Definitions. 15 The following words and phrases when used in this article shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 16 17 context clearly indicates otherwise: "COVID-19." The novel coronavirus as identified in the 18 proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the Governor on 19 March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and 20

- 1 any renewal of the state of disaster emergency.
- 2 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 3 <u>Commonwealth</u>.
- 4 "Eligible period." The period beginning March 6, 2020, to
- 5 the latest emergency date ordered by the Governor.
- 6 <u>"Eligible school employee." Includes, but is not limited to,</u>
- 7 teachers, paraprofessionals, school counselors, school
- 8 psychologists, school nurses, custodians, bus drivers, school
- 9 <u>nutrition staff, media specialists, clerical staff,</u>
- 10 instructional coaches and therapists who worked at or for a
- 11 <u>public school within this Commonwealth during the eligible</u>
- 12 period.
- 13 "Program." The COVID-19 School Employee Bonus Program
- 14 <u>established under section 2602-L(a).</u>
- 15 <u>Section 2602-L. COVID-19 School Employee Bonus Program.</u>
- 16 <u>(a) Establishment.--The COVID-19 School Employee Bonus</u>
- 17 Program is established within the department to assist school
- 18 employees who worked during the COVID-19 pandemic. The start
- 19 date for the program shall commence on the date that the
- 20 department posts the application form on the department's
- 21 publicly accessible Internet website under subsection (c)(1).
- 22 (b) Appropriation. -- From Federal amounts received by the
- 23 Commonwealth under Title IX, Subtitle M, Section 9901 of the
- 24 American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (Public Law 117-2, 135 Stat.
- 25 4), the sum of \$150,000,000 shall be distributed to the program.
- 26 (c) Applications. -- The following shall apply:
- 27 <u>(1) The department shall develop an application for</u>
- 28 participation in the program and post the application form on
- 29 the department's publicly accessible Internet website. An
- 30 applicant shall verify the following information on the

2	(i) The applicant's place of employment.
3	(ii) Whether the applicant worked full-time or part-
4	time during the eligible period.
5	(iii) Any other information required by the
6	<u>department.</u>
7	(2) In order to receive a direct payment under
8	subsection (e), an applicant must submit the application
9	under paragraph (1) to the department within 90 days of the
10	program's start date as specified under subsection (a).
11	(d) Verification The department shall verify with an
12	applicant's employer that the applicant worked during the
13	eligible period and the applicant's full-time or part-time work
14	status.
15	(e) Direct payments The following shall apply:
16	(1) Upon review and approval of the application
17	submitted under subsection (c) and any other documentation
18	required by the department, the department shall provide a
19	one-time direct payment to eligible school employees as
20	determined under paragraph (2).
21	(2) Upon the expiration of the application period under
22	subsection (c)(2), the department shall determine, using a
23	formula developed by the department, the amount of the direct
24	payments for full-time eligible school employees and for
25	part-time eligible school employees. The amount of the direct
26	payment for part-time eligible school employees may not
27	exceed 50% of the amount of the direct payment for full-time
28	eligible school employees.
29	(3) The department shall provide a direct payment to an
30	eligible school employee via mail or electronic deposit.

- 1 (f) Regulations. -- The department may promulgate any
- 2 regulations necessary to implement the program.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
