## AN ACT

| 7   | committed the abuse, neglect, abandonment or exploitation.       |
| 8   | (3) A description of the abuse, neglect, abandonment or          |
| 9   | exploitation committed by the perpetrator, including the date    |
| 10  | or dates of the incidents.                                       |
| 11  | (c) ExpungementThe department shall immediately expunge          |
| 12  | information in the registry pertaining to any perpetrator where  |
| 13  | the finding of the agency, as defined in 6 Pa. Code § 15.2       |
| 14  | (relating to definitions), has been reversed upon appeal under 6 |
| 15  | Pa. Code § 15.82(3) (relating to rights of alleged abusers).     |
| 16  | (d) Information submitted by prospective employees               |
| 17  | Administrators of facilities shall require prospective employees |
| 18  | to submit with their applications for employment a certification |
| 19  | from the department as to whether the applicant is named in the  |
| 20  | registry as a perpetrator. The certificate must be obtained      |
| 21  | within the one-year period of the submission date of the         |
| 22  | application.   |
