AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for and reorganizing the 2 conduct of the executive and administrative work of the 3 Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the 4 administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers 5 thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal 6 7 Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining 8 9 the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and 10 11 administrative officers, and of the several administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the 12 salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain 13 other executive and administrative officers; providing for 14 the appointment of certain administrative officers, and of 15 all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain 16 departments, boards, and commissions; providing for the 17 regulation of pari-mutuel thoroughbred horse racing and 18 harness horse racing activities, imposing certain taxes and 19 providing for the disposition of funds from pari-mutuel 20 21 tickets; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and 22 employes of certain departments, boards and commissions shall 23 be determined," in Commonwealth agency fees, providing for 24 25 method of payment. - 1 <u>Section 626-A. Method of Payment.</u>
- 2 An agency that permits the payment of a fee by check or money
- 3 order shall also accept payment of the fee with a debit card and
- 4 <u>credit card.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
