AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An
- act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in departmental powers and
- duties as to public assistance, providing for Supplemental
- Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) study.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known
- 9 as the Human Services Code, is amended by adding a section to
- 10 read:
- 11 Section 414.1. Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program
- 12 (SNAP) Study. -- (a) The department shall conduct a study and
- 13 issue a report on the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance
- 14 Program's outreach and application process.
- 15 (b) At a minimum, the report shall:
- 16 (1) Identify how the department can improve the outreach
- 17 process and ensure that Commonwealth residents who are eligible

- 1 for the program can access the program.
- 2 (2) Consider outreach strategies found in the United States
- 3 Department of Agriculture Food and Nutrition Service SNAP State
- 4 Outreach Plan.
- 5 (3) Identify areas of improvement for the program based on
- 6 strategies found in the United States Department of Agriculture
- 7 Food and Nutrition Service SNAP State Outreach Plan.
- 8 (4) Identify how the department can improve the outreach
- 9 process for underserved communities, including students,
- 10 veterans, older adults, immigrants, LGBTQ+ individuals and
- 11 mixed-status households.
- 12 (5) Identify how the department can improve the application
- 13 process to ensure that applicants have an accessible way of
- 14 applying to the program.
- 15 (6) Identify how county assistance offices can improve
- 16 <u>administrative processes to guarantee that required deadlines</u>
- 17 are being met, including electronic benefit transfer (EBT) card
- 18 replacements.
- 19 (c) The secretary shall submit the report under this section
- 20 to the following no later than one year after the effective date
- 21 of this section:
- 22 (1) The Governor.
- 23 (2) The President pro tempore of the Senate.
- 24 (3) The Speaker of the House of Representatives.
- 25 (4) The Majority Leader and the Minority Leader of the
- 26 Senate.
- 27 (5) The Majority Leader and the Minority Leader of the House
- 28 of Representatives.
- 29 (6) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the Health
- 30 and Human Services Committee of the Senate.

- 1 (7) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the Human
- 2 <u>Services Committee of the House of Representatives.</u>
- 3 (d) As used in this section, the term "program" means the
- 4 <u>Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) administered by</u>
- 5 <u>the department.</u>
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
