5	hereby enacts as follows:					
6	Section 1. Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated					
7	Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:

15	<u>§ 3901. Definitions.</u>					
16	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter					
17	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the					

1	context clearly indicates otherwise:
2	"Audit." The official inspection and review of the returns
3	of an election in accordance with this chapter.
4	"County." A county of this Commonwealth. The term includes a
5	county within which is located a city of the first class or with
6	which a city of the first class is coextensive.
7	"Election." A general election, municipal election, primary
8	election or special election.
9	"General election." The election that the Constitution of
10	<u>Pennsylvania requires to be held in even-numbered years.</u>
11	"Municipal election." The election that the Constitution of
12	<u>Pennsylvania requires to be held in odd-numbered years.</u>
13	"Primary election." An election held for the purpose of
14	nominating candidates for public offices to be voted for at a
15	general election or municipal election.
16	"Special election." An election authorized by law, other
17	than a general election, municipal election or primary election.
18	<u>§ 3902. Authorization.</u>
19	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Auditor
20	General shall conduct an annual performance audit of the county
21	results of each election to ensure the integrity of the
22	electoral process in this Commonwealth.
23	<u>§ 3903. Standards.</u>
24	An audit under this chapter shall be in accordance with the
25	standards of the following:
26	(1) Government Auditing Standards by the Comptroller
27	General of the United States (United States Government
28	Accountability Office, July 2018).
29	(2) SOC 2® Reporting on an Examination of Controls at a
30	Service Organization Relevant to Security, Availability,

3 <u>§ 3904. Subpoena power.</u>

4 <u>The Auditor General shall have power to subpoena persons</u>,

5 require the production of papers and records, compel the

6 attendance of witnesses and examine witnesses in performing the

7 <u>audit under this chapter.</u>

8 Section 2. This act shall apply to elections that occur 9 after December 31, 2022.

10 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
