AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in charter schools, further providing 5 for funding for charter schools. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 1725-A(a)(3) of the act of March 10, 1949 9 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 10 11 amended and the subsection is amended by adding a clause to 12 read: 13 Section 1725-A. Funding for Charter Schools.--(a) Funding 14 for a charter school shall be provided in the following manner: * * * 15 (3) For special education students, the charter school shall 16 17 receive for each student enrolled the same funding as for each 18 non-special education student as provided in clause (2), plus an additional amount determined by dividing the district of 19 20 residence's total special education expenditure by [the product

2	times the district of residence's total average daily membership
3	for the prior school year.] the total number of special
4	education students who reside in the school district. This
5	amount shall be paid by the district of residence of each
6	student.
7	(3.1) The following shall apply to clause (3):
8	(i) The total number of special education students who
9	reside in the school district shall be the sum of the following:
10	(A) The number of special education students who reside in
11	the school district for which the annual expenditure is in
12	<u>Category 1.</u>
13	(B) The number of special education students who reside in
14	the school district for which the annual expenditure is in
15	<u>Category 2.</u>
16	(C) The number of special education students who reside in
17	the school district for which the annual expenditure is in
18	<u>Category 3.</u>
19	(ii) The dollar ranges for the annual expenditure amounts
20	designated as Category 1, Category 2 and Category 3 under
21	subclause (i) and the data used to calculate the total number of
22	special education students who reside in the school district
23	under subclause (i) shall be the same as provided for under
24	<u>section 2509.5(bbb)(2)(vii) and (viii).</u>

26	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
