Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in offenses against public order and 2 decency, further providing for the offense of cruelty to 3 animals. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 5511(c)(2), (h)(1)(i), (2)(i), (3)(i), 8 (4)(i) and (5)(i) and (m.2) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 10 § 5511. Cruelty to animals. 11 * * * 12 (c) Cruelty to animals. --13 14 (2) The following apply: 15 Except as provided in subparagraph (ii), a 16 person convicted of violating paragraph (1) commits a 17 [summary offense] misdemeanor of the third degree.

(ii) A person convicted for a second or subsequent

1 time of violating paragraph (1) commits a misdemeanor of 2 the [third] second degree [if all of the following 3 occurred: The action or omission for which the person 4 5 was convicted for a subsequent time was performed on 6 a dog or cat. 7 The dog or cat was seriously injured, 8 suffered severe physical distress or was placed at imminent risk of serious physical harm as the result 9 10 of the person's action or omission]. * * * 11 12 Specific violations; prima facie evidence of 13 violation. --14 (i) A person commits a [summary offense] (1)misdemeanor of the third degree if the person crops, 15 16 trims or cuts off, or causes or procures to be cropped, trimmed or cut off, the whole or part of the ear or ears 17 18 of a dog. * * * 19 20 (2) (i) A person commits a [summary offense] 21 misdemeanor of the third degree if the person debarks a 22 dog by cutting, causing or procuring the cutting of its 23 vocal cords or by altering, causing or procuring the 24 alteration of any part of its resonance chamber.

misdemeanor of the third degree if the person docks, cuts

off, causes or procures the docking or cutting off of the

tail of a dog over five days old.

10 (m.2) Prohibition of ownership. -- Notwithstanding any

11 provision of law and in addition to any other penalty provided

12 by law, the authority imposing sentence upon a conviction for

13 any violation of this section may order the prohibition or

14 limitation of the defendant's ownership, possession, control or

15 custody of animals or employment with the care of animals for a

16 period of time not [to exceed] <u>less than</u> the statutory maximum

17 term of imprisonment applicable to the offense for which

18 sentence is being imposed.
