21	(1) A completed absentee ballot must be received in the
22	office of the county board of elections no later than eight

- 1 o'clock P.M. on the day of the primary or election.
- 2 (2) Any ballot received after eight o'clock P.M. on the day
- 3 of the primary or election shall be considered void.
- 4 (3) No declared disaster emergency, executive order or court
- 5 order may waive the deadline under this section.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
