AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge to be constructed on that portion of State
2 Route 119 over the Pine Run Creek, Rayne Township, Indiana
3 County, as the PFC Frank Enzer Weiss United States Marine
4 Corps Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. PFC Frank Enzer Weiss United States Marine Corps
8 Bridge.

9 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
10 follows:

11 (1) PFC Frank Enzer Weiss, a native of Tanoma, served in
12 the United States Marine Corps G Company, 2nd Battalion, 3rd
13 Marine Division, III Marine Amphibious Force.

14 (2) On March 18, 1968, PFC Weiss, 19 years of age, was
15 killed in action by hostile fire in Quang Tri Province, South
16 Vietnam.

17 (3) PFC Weiss was awarded the Purple Heart, National

1 Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal and Vietnam
2 Service Medal.

3 (b) Designation.--The bridge to be constructed on State
4 Route 119 over the Pine Run Creek in Rayne Township, Indiana
5 County, is designated the PFC Frank Enzer Weiss United States
6 Marine Corps Bridge.

7 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
8 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
9 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

10 Section 2. Effective date.

11 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
