- 30 No.16A), known as the Gaming Control Appropriation Act of 2020,

- 1 shall replace that appropriation.
- 2 Section 902. Deduction of expended appropriations under prior
- 3 law.
- 4 Any money which has been appropriated and expended under the
- 5 act of May 29, 2020 (P.L. No.16A), known as the Gaming Control
- 6 Appropriation Act of 2020, shall be deducted from the
- 7 corresponding appropriation in Part VIII of this act.
- 8 Section 903. Transfers prohibited.
- 9 There is no authority for the State Treasurer, the Secretary
- 10 of the Budget, the Secretary of Revenue or the Pennsylvania
- 11 Gaming Control Board to transfer any money within or between the
- 12 appropriations in Parts III, V, VII or VIII of this act.
- 13 Section 904. Effective date.
- 14 This act shall take effect July 1, 2021, or immediately,
- 15 whichever is later.
