## AN ACT

Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for organization of the Pennsylvania Game Commission. 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 301(c) of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 301. Organization of commission. 8 \* \* \* 9 10 (c) Term of office and compensation .--[The members] A member of the commission shall hold 11 12 office for not more than two terms of [eight] four years 13 each, subject to Senate confirmation pursuant to law for each 14 term, and may continue to hold office for a period of time 15 not to exceed [six] 12 months or until a successor is 16 appointed and qualified, whichever occurs first. Thereafter, the person shall be ineligible to hold that office. 17

(2) A member of the commission appointed to fill a

- 1 vacancy for a period of [four] <u>two</u> years or less may be
- 2 eligible for appointment to a full [eight-year] four-year
- 3 term. [A member of the commission who serves a full eight-
- 4 year term or fills a vacancy for a period of more than four
- 5 years shall not be eligible for reappointment to the
- 6 commission until a period of eight years expires.]
- 7 (3) Commissioners shall receive no compensation for
- 8 their services, but may be reimbursed for travel expenses.

- 10 Section 2. The amendment of 34 Pa.C.S. § 301(c) shall apply
- 11 to members of the commission appointed on or after the effective
- 12 date of this section.
- 13 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
