7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
10	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding an
11	article to read:
12	ARTICLE XX-K
13	TUITION EQUITY AND INCLUSION
14	Section 2001-K. Definitions.
15	The following words and phrases when used in this article
16	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
17	context clearly indicates otherwise:
18	"Department." The Department of Education of the

1	Commonwealth.
2	"PHEAA." The Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance
3	Agency.
4	"Public institution of higher education." Any of the
5	following:
6	(1) A community college under Article XIX-A.
7	(2) A university within the State System of Higher
8	Education under Article XX-A.
9	(3) A State-related institution as defined in section
10	<u>1502-A.</u>
11	<u>Section 2002-K. Eligibility.</u>
12	(a) RequirementsAn individual shall be exempt from paying
13	out-of-State tuition rates at a public institution of higher
14	education if the individual:
15	(1) Is other than a nonimmigrant within the meaning of:
16	(i) 8 U.S.C. § 1101(a)(15)(F), (H)(iii) or (J)
17	(relating to definitions) and including only a student or
18	trainee; or
19	<u>(ii) 8 U.S.C. § 1101(a)(15)(M).</u>
20	(2) Attended a public, nonpublic, charter or cyber
21	charter secondary school in this Commonwealth for at least
22	<u>two years.</u>
23	(3) Graduated from a public, nonpublic, charter or cyber
24	charter secondary school in this Commonwealth or received the
25	equivalent of a high school diploma in this Commonwealth.
26	(b) EvidenceThe department shall issue guidance to public
27	institutions of higher education on what evidence is acceptable
28	to prove the requirements under this section.

2	individual under this article shall:
3	(1) Keep a record of the number of individuals admitted
4	under this article and annually report this information to
5	the department.
6	(2) Adopt appropriate policies to implement the
7	provisions of this article.
8	Section 2004-K. Financial aid.
9	(a) EligibilityAn individual who meets the requirements
10	under section 2002-K(a) and is accepted by a public institution
11	of higher education in this Commonwealth shall be eligible for
12	financial aid through PHEAA.
13	(b) ApplicationPHEAA shall create an alternative
14	financial aid application for an individual under this section.
15	The application shall not require the Social Security number of
16	the individual or a parent of the individual.
17	<u>Section 2005-K. Duties of department.</u>
18	The department shall prepare an annual report consisting of a
19	compilation of the reports submitted to the department under
20	section 2003-K(1). The report shall be submitted to the
21	chairperson and minority chairperson of the Education Committee
22	of the Senate and the chairperson and minority chairperson of
23	the Education Committee of the House of Representatives.
24	Section 2006-K. Confidentiality.
25	Information obtained under this article is confidential and
26	shall be used or disclosed only for purposes of administering
27	this article.
28	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
