AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, in assault, further providing for the
- offense of ethnic intimidation.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 2710 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 2710. Ethnic and employment intimidation.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits the offense of ethnic
- 10 <u>and employment</u> intimidation if, with malicious intention toward
- 11 the race, color, religion [or], national origin or employment as
- 12 a law enforcement officer of another individual or group of
- 13 individuals, he commits an offense under any other provision of
- 14 this article or under Chapter 33 (relating to arson, criminal
- 15 mischief and other property destruction) exclusive of section
- 16 3307 (relating to institutional vandalism) or under section 3503
- 17 (relating to criminal trespass) with respect to such individual
- 18 or his or her property or with respect to one or more members of

- 1 such group or to their property.
- 2 (b) Grading. -- An offense under this section shall be
- 3 classified as a misdemeanor of the third degree if the other
- 4 offense is classified as a summary offense. Otherwise, an
- 5 offense under this section shall be classified one degree higher
- 6 in the classification specified in section 106 (relating to
- 7 classes of offenses) than the classification of the other
- 8 offense.
- 9 (c) [Definition.--As used in this section "malicious
- 10 intention" means the] Definitions. -- As used in this section, the
- 11 following words and phrases shall have the meanings given to
- 12 them in this subsection unless the context clearly indicates
- 13 otherwise:
- 14 "Law enforcement officer." A person who by virtue of his
- 15 office or public employment is vested by law with a duty to
- 16 <u>maintain public order or to make arrests for offenses, whether</u>
- 17 that duty extends to all offenses or is limited to specific
- 18 offenses, or any person on active State duty under 51 Pa.C.S. §
- 19 508 (relating to active duty for emergency). The term includes a
- 20 corrections officer, a parole agent and a member of a park
- 21 police department in a county of the third class.
- 22 "Malicious intention." The intention to commit any act, the
- 23 commission of which is a necessary element of any offense
- 24 referred to in subsection (a) motivated by hatred toward the
- 25 race, color, religion [or], national origin or employment as a
- 26 <u>law enforcement officer</u> of another individual or group of
- 27 individuals.
- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
