## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, 2 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 3 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating 4 and defining membership of county boards of elections; 5 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, 6 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; 7 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 8 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 9 10 elections," in voting by qualified absentee electors, further 11 providing for canvassing of official absentee ballots and 12 mail-in ballots. 13 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1308(q)(1.1) of the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is 17 18 amended to read: 19 Section 1308. Canvassing of Official Absentee Ballots and Mail-in Ballots.--\* \* \* 20 21 (g) \* \* \* 22 (1.1) [The county board of elections shall meet no earlier

- 1 than seven o'clock A.M. on election day to pre-canvass all
- 2 ballots received prior to the meeting.] The following apply:
- 3 (i) A county board of elections shall meet as follows:
- 4 (A) In a county of the first class, second class or second
- 5 class A, the county board of elections shall meet no earlier
- 6 than seven o'clock A.M. fourteen (14) days prior to election day
- 7 to pre-canvass ballots received prior to the meeting and through
- 8 <u>one day before election day.</u>
- 9 (B) In a county of the third class, the county board of
- 10 elections shall meet no earlier than seven o'clock A.M. seven
- 11 (7) days prior to election day to pre-canvass ballots received
- 12 prior to the meeting and through one day before election day.
- 13 (C) In a county of the fourth class, fifth class, sixth
- 14 class, seventh class or eighth class, the county board of
- 15 elections shall meet no earlier than seven o'clock A.M. three
- 16 (3) days prior to election day to pre-canvass ballots received
- 17 prior to the meeting and through one day before election day.
- 18 <u>(ii)</u> A county board of elections shall provide at least
- 19 forty-eight hours' notice of a pre-canvass meeting by publicly
- 20 posting a notice of a pre-canvass meeting on its publicly
- 21 accessible Internet website. One authorized representative of
- 22 each candidate in an election and one representative from each
- 23 political party shall be permitted to remain in the room in
- 24 which the absentee ballots and mail-in ballots are pre-
- 25 canvassed. No person observing, attending or participating in a
- 26 pre-canvass meeting may disclose the results of any portion of
- 27 any pre-canvass meeting prior to the close of the polls.

- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
