Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled

"An act relating to counties of the first, second class A, 2 third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto; relating to imposition of excise taxes by counties, including authorizing imposition of an excise tax on the rental of motor vehicles by counties of the first class; and providing for regional renaissance initiatives," in names and corporate powers, classification of counties, 9 further providing for ascertainment, certification and effect 10 of change of class; and making related repeals. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. - 1 the effective date of this subsection shall remain unchanged
- 2 until the 2030 census, at which time the procedures established
- 3 in subsections (a), (b) and (c) shall apply. For the purposes of
- 4 <u>determining whether a county has decreased in population so as</u>
- 5 to recede in classification under subsection (b) following the
- 6 2030 decennial census, both the 2020 and 2030 decennial censuses
- 7 shall be considered.
- 8 (D) UNLESS THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF A COUNTY MEETING <--
- 9 THE REQUISITE COUNTY POPULATION LEVELS IN SECTION 210 ENACTS AN
- 10 ORDINANCE OR ADOPTS A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CHANGE OF
- 11 CLASSIFICATION PRIOR TO FEBRUARY 22, 2022, AS A RESULT OF THE
- 12 DELAYS IN THE 2020 FEDERAL DECENNIAL CENSUS AND THE COVID-19
- 13 PANDEMIC, THE CLASSIFICATION OF ALL COUNTIES AS OF THE EFFECTIVE
- 14 DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL REMAIN UNCHANGED UNTIL THE 2030
- 15 CENSUS, AT WHICH TIME THE PROCEDURES ESTABLISHED IN SUBSECTIONS
- 16 (A), (B) AND (C) SHALL APPLY. FOR THE PURPOSES OF DETERMINING
- 17 WHETHER A COUNTY HAS DECREASED IN POPULATION SO AS TO RECEDE IN
- 18 CLASSIFICATION UNDER SUBSECTION (B) FOLLOWING THE 2030 DECENNIAL
- 19 CENSUS, BOTH THE 2020 AND 2030 DECENNIAL CENSUSES SHALL BE
- 20 CONSIDERED.
- 21 Section 2. Repeals are as follows:
- 22 (1) The General Assembly declares that the repeals under
- 23 paragraph (2) are necessary to effectuate the addition of
- 24 section 211(d).
- 25 (2) Sections 210 and 211 of the act of July 28, 1953
- 26 (P.L.723, No.230), known as the Second Class County Code, are
- 27 repealed.
- Section 3. This act shall take effect September 30, 2021, or
- 29 immediately, whichever is later.
