## AN ACT

Amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in lobbying disclosure, further providing for definitions and for prohibited activities. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 13A03 of Title 65 of the Pennsylvania 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition-<--DEFINITIONS to read: <--§ 13A03. Definitions. The following words and phrases when used in this chapter 10 11 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 12 context clearly indicates otherwise: \* \* \* 13 "Campaign consultant." An individual that WHO receives 14 compensation for PROFESSIONAL campaign-related professional 15 services, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, POLITICAL, STRATEGIC, 16

- 1 ADVISORY OR FUNDRAISING SERVICES, rendered to a campaign to
- 2 elect an individual to office.

- 4 "OFFICE OF A STATE OFFICIAL." ANY STAFF, WHETHER COMPENSATED <--
- 5 OR UNCOMPENSATED, WHO ARE SUPERVISED OR MANAGED BY A STATE
- 6 OFFICIAL AND WHO ARE INVOLVED IN LEGISLATIVE ACTION OR
- 7 ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION.

- 9 Section 2. Section 13A07(f)(1) of Title 65 is amended by
- 10 adding a subparagraph to read:
- 11 § 13A07. Prohibited activities.

- 13 (f) Unlawful acts.--
- 14 (1) A lobbyist or principal may not:
- 15 \* \* \*
- 16 <u>(xi) Engage in lobbying a State official or a State</u> <-17 <u>employee on the State official's staff after serving as a</u>
  18 <u>campaign consultant for the State official or after</u>
- 19 <u>having a pecuniary interest in a campaign consultant that</u>
- 20 <u>rendered campaign consulting services for the State</u>
- 21 <u>official. This prohibition shall only apply for the term</u>
- 22 <u>in which the State official was elected and for which the</u>
- 23 <u>campaign consulting services were provided.</u>
- 24 (XI) ENGAGE IN LOBBYING A STATE OFFICIAL OR THE
- 25 OFFICE OF A STATE OFFICIAL AFTER SERVING AS A CAMPAIGN
- 26 CONSULTANT FOR THE STATE OFFICIAL OR AFTER HAVING A
- 27 <u>PECUNIARY INTEREST IN A CAMPAIGN CONSULTANT THAT RENDERED</u>
- 28 SERVICES FOR THE STATE OFFICIAL. THIS PROHIBITION SHALL
- 29 APPLY FOR ONE YEAR AFTER THE DATE OF THE ELECTION FOR
- 30 WHICH THE SERVICES WERE RENDERED.
