## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.789, No.285), entitled "An 1 act relating to insurance; establishing an insurance 2 department; and amending, revising, and consolidating the law 3 relating to the licensing, qualification, regulation, 4 examination, suspension, and dissolution of insurance 5 companies, Lloyds associations, reciprocal and inter-6 7 insurance exchanges, and certain societies and orders, the examination and regulation of fire insurance rating bureaus, 8 and the licensing and regulation of insurance agents and 9 brokers; the service of legal process upon foreign insurance 10 companies, associations or exchanges; providing penalties, 11 and repealing existing laws," in insurance producers, further 12 providing for imposition of additional fees. 13 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. Section 674-A(b) of the act of May 17, 1921 17 (P.L.789, No.285), known as The Insurance Department Act of 18 1921, is amended and the section is amended by adding 19 subsections to read: 20 Section 674-A. Imposition of additional fees. 21 \* \* \* 22 Application fee. -- Notwithstanding other provisions of (b) 23 this section, no insurance producer shall charge a fee for the completion of an application for [a] an individual contract of 24

| 3  | (c) Notice to consumersAn insurance producer who charges       |

| 15 | Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.              |
