4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 13A07 of Title 65 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8	§ 13A07. Prohibited activities.

10	(g) Employee of the General Assembly OR EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT <
11	OR AGENCYA lobbyist, lobbying firm or principal may not lobby_<
12	an individual who is an employee of the General Assembly and who
13	was an employee of a lobbying firm for one year after the date
14	the individual left employment with the lobbying firm. A <
15	LOBBYING FIRM OR PRINCIPAL MAY NOT LOBBY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AN
16	EMPLOYEE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OR AN EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT OR

1	AGENCY, AND WHO WAS AN EMPLOYEE OF THAT LOBBYING FIRM OR
2	PRINCIPAL, FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR AFTER THE DATE THE
3	INDIVIDUAL LEFT EMPLOYMENT WITH THE LOBBYING FIRM OR PRINCIPAL.
4	THIS PROHIBITION SHALL EXTEND TO LOBBYING BY ANY LOBBYIST
5	EMPLOYED BY THE SAME LOBBYING FIRM OR PRINCIPAL. For the
6	purposes of this subsection, "employee of the General Assembly"
7	shall mean employment with any of the following:
8	(1) The office of a member of the General Assembly.
9	(2) Any of the caucuses of the General Assembly.
10	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 180 days. <
