AN ACT

- 1 Establishing the Governor's Schools of Excellence.
- 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 3 hereby enacts as follows:
- 4 Section 1. Short title.
- 5 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Governor's
- 6 Schools of Excellence Act.
- 7 Section 2. Legislative intent.
- 8 It is the intent of the General Assembly to establish the
- 9 permanent operation of the Governor's Schools of Excellence in
- 10 order to afford students of all socioeconomic backgrounds the
- 11 opportunity to pursue in-depth and advanced studies in fields
- 12 that may include, but are not limited to, agricultural sciences,
- 13 engineering and technology, sciences or arts.
- 14 Section 3. Definitions.
- 15 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 16 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 17 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 1 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 2 Commonwealth.
- 3 "Governor's School of Excellence." A school established by
- 4 the department under section 5.
- 5 "Host site." A college or university within this
- 6 Commonwealth where a Governor's School of Excellence is located.
- 7 "Program." The Governor's Schools of Excellence Program
- 8 established under section 4.
- 9 Section 4. Governor's Schools of Excellence Program.
- 10 The Governor's Schools of Excellence Program is established
- 11 within the department.
- 12 Section 5. Duties of department.
- 13 (a) Disciplines.--The department shall establish at least
- 14 five Governor's Schools of Excellence at host sites throughout
- 15 this Commonwealth in disciplines that may include any of the
- 16 following:
- 17 (1) Agricultural sciences.
- 18 (2) Engineering and technology.
- 19 (3) Sciences.
- 20 (4) Arts.
- 21 (5) Other disciplines determined by the department.
- 22 (b) Locations.--
- 23 (1) Governor's Schools of Excellence may be sponsored by
- and located at host sites designated by the department.
- 25 (2) The department shall designate host sites on a
- 26 competitive basis, based upon criteria to be determined by
- 27 the department and published on the department's publicly
- 28 accessible Internet website.
- 29 (3) In order to be designated by the department, the
- 30 host site shall provide at least 50% of the cost to operate

- 1 the Governor's School of Excellence.
- 2 (4) Host sites designated by the department shall be
- 3 geographically dispersed throughout this Commonwealth.
- 4 (c) Administration.--In administering the program, the
- 5 department shall do all of the following:
- 6 (1) Make student applications available to every public
- 7 school and nonpublic school in this Commonwealth and include
- 8 the application on the department's publicly accessible
- 9 Internet website.
- 10 (2) Ensure that each Governor's School of Excellence is
- 11 utilizing a process in which students are selected on the
- 12 basis of student performance and achievement through a
- 13 competitive selection process and seek to ensure an
- 14 economically, socially and geographically diverse student
- 15 population.
- 16 (3) Ensure the Governor's School of Excellence complies
- 17 with subsection (e), enabling all qualified students the
- 18 opportunity to enroll in the program regardless of the
- 19 student's economic circumstances.
- 20 (d) Scheduling.--Governor's Schools of Excellence shall be
- 21 held, to the extent possible, during the summer months between
- 22 the end and the beginning of the school year. The department may
- 23 grant permission for a school to be held at other times during
- 24 the school year when circumstances and programming options
- 25 warrant that change.
- 26 (e) Costs.--Students attending a Governor's School of
- 27 Excellence may not be required to pay any tuition or fees to
- 28 attend and participate in a Governor's School of Excellence.
- 29 Students shall be responsible for their own costs relating to
- 30 transportation to and from the Governor's School of Excellence.

- 1 Section 6. Effective date.
- 2 This act shall take effect immediately.
