## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled "An act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and 2 brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating and 3 changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession, consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding 6 in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the 7 8 persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and 9 10 duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores, 11 for the payment of certain license fees to the respective 12 municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain 13 nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure 14 without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures; 15 providing for local option, and repealing existing laws," in 16 Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board, further providing for 17 enforcement. 18 19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 20 hereby enacts as follows: 21 Section 1. Section 211 of the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, 22 No.21), known as the Liquor Code, is amended by adding a 23 subsection to read: Section 211. Enforcement. -- \* \* \* 24 25 (h) If a licensee is reported to the Bureau of Liquor

Control Enforcement for a violation of this act and that report

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- 1 <u>leads to an investigation, the Bureau of Liquor Control</u>
- 2 Enforcement shall disclose the person who made the report to the
- 3 <u>licensee.</u>
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
