| 24 | The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania |
| 25 | hereby enacts as follows: |
| 26 | Section 1. Section 10(ee) of the act of May 28, 1937 |
| 27 | (P.L.955, No.265), referred to as the Housing Authorities Law, |
| 28 | is amended to read: |

Section 10. Powers of an Authority.--An Authority shall constitute a public body, corporate and politic, exercising public powers of the Commonwealth as an agency thereof, which powers shall include all powers necessary or appropriate to carry out and effectuate the purpose and provisions of this act, including the following powers, in addition to others herein granted:

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9 (ee) In a county of the second class and [city] cities of 10 the second [class] and third classes, to appoint police officers 11 who shall exercise the same powers that may be exercised under 12 authority of law or ordinance by the police of the 13 municipalities wherein the Authority is located, including, but 14 not limited to, those powers conferred pursuant to 42 Pa.C.S. 15 Ch. 89 Subch. D (relating to municipal police jurisdiction) with 16 respect to the property and enforcing order on and adjacent to 17 the grounds and buildings of the Authority: Provided, That said police officers complete the same course of instruction as is 18 19 required for municipal police officers by 53 Pa.C.S. Ch. 21 Subch. D (relating to municipal police education and training) 20 21 and receive certification by the Municipal Police Officers' 22 Education and Training Commission as having completed the 23 instruction. Said police officers shall maintain the 24 certification as a condition of employment as police officers 25 for the Authority.

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27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
