11	(1) causes any waste paper, sweepings, ashes, household
12	waste, grass clippings or other landscaping matter, glass,
13	metal, refuse or rubbish, or any dangerous or detrimental
14	substance to be deposited into or upon any road, street,
15	highway, alley or railroad right-of-way, or upon the land of
16	another or into the waters of this Commonwealth;

18	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
