7	Section 1. Section 1511(e) of Title 15 of the Pennsylvania

9	§ 1511. Additional powers of certain public utility

12	(e) Streets and other public placesA public utility
13	corporation shall have the right to enter upon and occupy
14	streets, highways, waters and other public ways and places for
15	one or more of the principal purposes specified in subsection
16	(a) and ancillary purposes reasonably necessary or appropriate
17	for the accomplishment of the principal purposes, including the
18	placement, maintenance and removal of aerial, surface and
19	subsurface public utility facilities thereon or therein. Before

entering upon any street, highway or other public way, the 1 public utility corporation shall obtain such permits as may be 2 3 required by law and shall comply with the lawful and reasonable regulations of the governmental authority having responsibility 4 for the maintenance thereof. Any requirements imposed by the 5 governmental authority concerning the restoration of streets, 6 7 highways or other public ways after the installation, 8 maintenance, repair, modification or removal of public utility 9 facilities, whether the requirements are imposed by ordinance, regulation, permit or other means, shall not exceed the permit 10 fees and restoration standards adopted by the Department of 11 Transportation as specified under 67 Pa. Code § 459.4 (relating 12 13 to permit fees), 459.8 (relating to special conditions-14 subsurface operations) or 459.9 (relating to special conditions, aboveground facilities). 15 16 * * *

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
