Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in rules of the road in general, further providing for additional parking regulations.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 3354 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: § 3354. Additional parking regulations.

(b.1) Protected pedalevele lanes. When there is a

(1) WHEN THERE IS AN ON-STREET PEDESTRIAN PLAZA OR
PEDALCYCLE LANE ADJACENT TO THE RIGHT-HAND CURB OF A TWO-WAY
OR ONE-WAY HIGHWAY, A VEHICLE STANDING OR PARKED UPON THE
