## AN ACT

- Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 21481, carrying State Route 1051, also known as Main Street, over Little
- 3 Cocalico Creek in the Borough of Denver, Lancaster County, as
- 4 the Fichthorn and Marburger Memorial Bridge.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Fichthorn and Marburger Memorial Bridge.
- 8 (a) Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 9 follows:
- 10 (1) Samuel E. Fichthorn, Daniel E. Fichthorn and Ambrose
- 11 Marburger were the founders of the F&M Hat Company.
- 12 (2) In 1912, the F&M Hat Company was incorporated in
- 13 Denver, Pennsylvania.
- 14 (3) The F&M Hat Company was a pioneer in harnessing
- 15 steam power for wool felt hat manufacturing.
- 16 (b) Designation. -- The bridge, identified as Bridge Key
- 17 21481, carrying State Route 1051, also known as Main Street,
- 18 over Little Cocalico Creek in the Borough of Denver, Lancaster
- 19 County, is designated the Fichthorn and Marburger Memorial

- 1 Bridge.
- 2 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 3 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 4 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 5 Section 2. Effective date.
- 6 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
