AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in certification of teachers, repealing provisions relating to CPR instruction; and, in 7 school health services, repealing provisions relating to automatic external defibrillators and providing for AED and 8 CPR instruction and procedure, for Automated External 9 Defibrillator Program, AND for availability and 10 <-specifications of automated external defibrillators and for <--11 sudden cardiac event emergency action plan for athletic 12 activities. 13 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. Sections 1205.4 and 1423 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, 17 18 are repealed: 19 [Section 1205.4. CPR Instruction.--(a) School entities 20 shall be required to offer a cardiopulmonary resuscitation 21 training (CPR) class on school premises at least once every

- 1 three years. The course shall be offered as an option to all
- 2 employes of the school entity.
- 3 (b) Completion of training, including testing of skills and
- 4 knowledge, shall be documented by the signature and title of a
- 5 representative of the training entity and shall include the date
- 6 training was completed. Documentation shall be retained in the
- 7 facility in that employe's file. Training shall be conducted by:
- 8 (1) the American Red Cross;
- 9 (2) the American Heart Association;
- 10 (3) an individual certified to conduct CPR training by the
- 11 American Red Cross, American Heart Association or other
- 12 certifying agency approved by the Department of Health; or
- (4) other certifying agency approved by the Department of
- 14 Health.
- 15 (c) School districts may include this training in the
- 16 continuing education plan submitted by the district to the
- 17 Department of Education under section 1205.1.
- (d) For purposes of this section, a school entity shall be
- 19 defined as a local school district, intermediate unit or area
- 20 career and technical school.
- 21 Section 1423. Automatic External Defibrillators.--(a) The
- 22 department shall establish an automatic external defibrillator
- 23 program to assist school entities and nonpublic schools in
- 24 making automatic external defibrillators available in school
- 25 buildings.
- (b) On a biennial basis, the department, in consultation
- 27 with the Department of General Services and the Department of
- 28 Health, shall issue an invitation to bid for the cost of
- 29 automatic external defibrillators and other equipment and
- 30 supplies necessary for the proper operation of the device. The

- 1 department shall accept the bid of the lowest responsible bidder
- 2 and permit any school entity or nonpublic school to purchase the
- 3 devices at the contract bid price. The department may purchase
- 4 automatic external defibrillators from any funds appropriated
- 5 pursuant to subsection (k) for distribution to school entities
- 6 and nonpublic schools.
- 7 (c) To be eligible to obtain or purchase automatic external
- 8 defibrillators under the program a school entity or nonpublic
- 9 school must:
- 10 (1) Assure that two (2) or more persons assigned to the
- 11 location where the automatic external defibrillator will be
- 12 primarily housed are trained as required in subsection (d).
- 13 (2) Ensure that the device will be secured in a safe and
- 14 readily accessible location and agree to properly maintain and
- 15 test the device according to the manufacturer's operational
- 16 quidelines.
- 17 (3) Submit a valid prescription for the device from a
- 18 licensed medical practitioner in this Commonwealth.
- (4) Agree to provide the training required by subsection
- 20 (d).
- 21 (d) School personnel who are expected to use the automatic
- 22 external defibrillator shall complete training in
- 23 cardiopulmonary resuscitation and in the use of an automatic
- 24 external defibrillator provided by the American Heart
- 25 Association, the American Red Cross or through an equivalent
- 26 course of instruction approved by the Department of Health.
- (e) A school entity may include the training required by
- 28 subsection (d) in its continuing professional education plan
- 29 submitted to the department under section 1205.1.
- 30 (f) The provisions of 42 Pa.C.S. § 8331.2 (relating to good

- 1 Samaritan civil immunity for use of automated external
- 2 defibrillator) shall apply to school employes who render care
- 3 with an automatic external defibrillator.
- 4 (g) From funds appropriated for this purpose, the department
- 5 may assist school entities and nonpublic schools that are not
- 6 equipped with automatic external defibrillators by providing a
- 7 discount from the contract bid price obtained under subsection
- 8 (b) or by providing automatic external defibrillators obtained
- 9 under subsection (b).
- 10 (g.1) The purchase of an automatic external defibrillator
- 11 shall be considered an allowable use of Pennsylvania
- 12 Accountability Grants under section 2599.2(b).
- 13 (g.2) The purchase of automatic external defibrillators
- 14 shall be considered an innovative educational program under
- 15 Article XVII-F of the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known
- 16 as the "Tax Reform Code of 1971."
- (h) (Reserved).
- (i) Not later than June 30, 2014, and each year thereafter,
- 19 each school entity shall make a report to the department
- 20 detailing the number, condition, age and placement of automatic
- 21 external defibrillators in each school building. After the
- 22 initial report is made, a school entity may report this
- 23 information as part of the annual report required by the
- 24 Commonwealth under section 2505.1 to receive State reimbursement
- 25 for health services.
- 26 (i.1) A nonpublic school that participates in the automatic
- 27 external defibrillator program under subsection (b) or (g) shall
- 28 be subject to the reporting required under subsection (i).
- (i.2) The department shall annually publish a report on its
- 30 publicly accessible Internet website no later than December 31,

- 1 2014, and each year thereafter. The report shall contain the
- 2 following information:
- 3 (1) The total number of automatic external defibrillators by
- 4 school entity and nonpublic school.
- 5 (2) The number of school buildings by school entity and
- 6 nonpublic school that are equipped with automatic external
- 7 defibrillators.
- 8 (3) The number of school buildings by school entity and
- 9 nonpublic school that are not equipped with automatic external
- 10 defibrillators.
- 11 (j) The department may adopt guidelines as necessary to
- 12 administer this section.
- (k) The General Assembly may appropriate funds to carry out
- 14 the provisions of this section.
- (1) As used in this section--
- "Automatic external defibrillator" means a portable device
- 17 that uses electric shock to restore a stable heart rhythm to an
- 18 individual in cardiac arrest.
- "Department" means the Department of Education of the
- 20 Commonwealth.
- "Nonpublic school" means a nonprofit school, other than a
- 22 public school within this Commonwealth, wherein a resident of
- 23 this Commonwealth may legally fulfill the compulsory school
- 24 attendance requirements of this act and which meets the
- 25 applicable requirements of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of
- 26 1964 (Public Law 88-352, 78 Stat. 241).
- "School building" means a building owned by or under the
- 28 control of a school entity or nonpublic school where classes are
- 29 taught or extracurricular activities are conducted on a regular
- 30 basis.

- 1 "School entity" means an area career and technical school, a
- 2 charter school, a cyber charter school, an intermediate unit or
- 3 a school district.
- "Secretary" means the Secretary of Education of the
- 5 Commonwealth.]
- 6 Section 2. The act is amended by adding sections to read:
- 7 Section 1423.1. AED and CPR Instruction and Procedure. -- (a)
- 8 Each school entity shall make available to the school entity's
- 9 <u>employes and volunteers instruction in the principles and</u>
- 10 techniques of cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an
- 11 <u>automated external defibrillator on school premises at least</u>
- 12 <u>once every two years. The following apply:</u>
- 13 (1) The instruction shall be offered as an option to all
- 14 school entity employes and volunteers.
- 15 (2) The instruction shall be conducted by any of the
- 16 following:
- 17 <u>(i) The American Red Cross.</u>
- 18 (ii) The American Heart Association.
- 19 (iii) An individual certified to conduct CPR training by the
- 20 American Red Cross, American Heart Association or other
- 21 <u>certifying agency approved by the Department of Health.</u>
- 22 (iv) Another certifying agency approved by the Department of
- 23 Health.
- 24 (3) A school entity, nonpublic school or private school, as
- 25 applicable, may provide the instruction under this section
- 26 through the Internet or other electronic means.
- 27 (b) The following apply to AED and CPR instruction:
- 28 <u>(1) Each school entity shall ensure that at least one (1)</u>
- 29 individual trained and certified in the use of an AED and CPR is
- 30 present in each school building during each school day.

- 1 (2) Each school nurse or designee, coach of an athletic
- 2 <u>activity</u>, MARCHING BAND DIRECTOR, physical education teacher,
- 3 <u>athletic trainer and athletic training student aide within each</u>
- 4 school entity must participate in the instruction in the use of
- 5 an AED and CPR.
- 6 (3) An individual described in this subsection must complete
- 7 the instruction and maintain certification in the use of an AED
- 8 in accordance with this section.
- 9 (c) The following apply to continuing education
- 10 <u>requirements:</u>
- 11 (1) A school entity may include the instruction under this
- 12 <u>section in the continuing education plan submitted by the</u>
- 13 <u>district to the department under section 1205.1.</u>
- 14 (2) Satisfying the instruction requirements of this section
- 15 shall also satisfy the training requirements under section
- 16 <u>1425 (d)</u>.
- 17 (d) Completion of instruction under subsections (a) and (b),
- 18 including the testing of skills and knowledge, shall be
- 19 documented by the signature and title of a representative of the
- 20 training entity and shall include the date that the instruction
- 21 was completed. The documentation shall be retained by the school
- 22 entity in the file of the employe or volunteer that completed
- 23 the training.
- (e) The following apply to a cardiac emergency response
- 25 plan:
- 26 (1) Each school entity, nonpublic school or private school
- 27 <u>shall develop or amend an existing cardiac emergency response</u>
- 28 plan FOR SCHOOLS AND SCHOOL ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES that includes:
- 29 <u>(i) Nationally recognized evidence-based core elements or</u>
- 30 standards.

- 1 (ii) An annual review.
- 2 (iii) Safety procedures to follow in response to a medical
- 3 emergency involving cardiac arrest and the use of an AED.
- 4 (iv) The placement of AEDs on school premises.
- 5 (2) The cardiac emergency response plan of each school
- 6 entity, nonpublic school or private school shall:
- 7 (i) Make available cardiac awareness information to school
- 8 employes and those responsible for extracurricular activities of
- 9 the school entity.
- 10 (ii) Require conducting annual sudden cardiac arrest drills
- 11 with or without the participation of students to test the
- 12 <u>cardiac emergency response plan in response to a sudden cardiac</u>
- 13 <u>arrest</u>.
- 14 (f) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 15 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 16 <u>the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 17 <u>"Athletic activity" means as defined</u> in section 1425(h).
- 18 "Automated external defibrillator" or "AED" means a portable
- 19 device that uses electric shock to restore a stable heart rhythm
- 20 to an individual in cardiac arrest.
- 21 "CPR" means cardiopulmonary resuscitation.
- 22 "Department" means the Department of Education of the
- 23 Commonwealth.
- "Nonpublic school" means a nonprofit school, other than a
- 25 public school within this Commonwealth, wherein a resident of
- 26 this Commonwealth may legally fulfill the compulsory school
- 27 <u>attendance requirements of this act and which meets the</u>
- 28 applicable requirements of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of
- 29 <u>1964 (Public Law 88-352, 78 Stat. 241).</u>
- 30 "Private school" means a school licensed under the act of

- 1 <u>December 15, 1986 (P.L.1585, No.174), known as the Private</u>
- 2 Licensed Schools Act.
- 3 "School building" means a building owned by or under the
- 4 control of a school entity, nonpublic school or private school
- 5 where classes are taught or extracurricular activities are
- 6 conducted on a regular basis.
- 7 "School day" means the length of time that a child subject to
- 8 compulsory school attendance is expected to be receiving
- 9 <u>instruction during a calendar day as determined by the governing</u>
- 10 <u>body</u>.
- "School entity" means a school district, charter school,
- 12 regional charter school, cyber charter school, intermediate unit
- 13 or area career and technical school.
- 14 <u>"Volunteer" means an individual who holds an unpaid position</u>
- 15 with a school entity as a volunteer for a program, activity or
- 16 <u>service and is responsible for the welfare of children or has</u>
- 17 direct volunteer contact.
- 18 <u>Section 1423.2. Automated External Defibrillator Program.--</u>
- 19 (a) The department shall establish the Automated External
- 20 <u>Defibrillator Program to assist school entities, nonpublic</u>
- 21 schools and private schools in making AEDs available in school
- 22 buildings.
- 23 (b) On a biennial basis, the department, in consultation
- 24 with the Department of General Services and the Department of
- 25 Health, shall issue an invitation to bid for the cost of AEDs
- 26 and other equipment and supplies necessary for the proper
- 27 operation of the device. The department shall accept the bid of
- 28 the lowest responsible bidder and permit any school entity,
- 29 <u>nonpublic school or private school to purchase the devices at</u>
- 30 the contract bid price. The department may purchase AEDs from

- 1 any money appropriated in accordance with subsection (1) for
- 2 <u>distribution to school entities</u>, <u>nonpublic schools or private</u>
- 3 schools.
- 4 (c) To be eligible to obtain or purchase AEDs under the
- 5 program, a school entity, nonpublic school or private school
- 6 must:
- 7 (1) Comply with the provisions in section 1423.1.
- 8 (2) Ensure that the AED will be secured in a safe and
- 9 readily accessible location and agree to properly maintain and
- 10 <u>test the device according to the manufacturer's operational</u>
- 11 <u>quidelines</u>.
- 12 (3) Submit a valid prescription for the device from a
- 13 <u>licensed medical practitioner in this Commonwealth.</u>
- 14 (d) The provisions of 42 Pa.C.S. § 8331.2 (relating to good
- 15 Samaritan civil immunity for use of automated external
- 16 <u>defibrillator</u>) shall apply to school entity, nonpublic school or
- 17 private school employes who render care with an AED.
- 18 (e) From money appropriated for the purposes under this
- 19 section, the department may assist school entities, nonpublic
- 20 schools and private schools that are not equipped with AEDs by
- 21 providing a discount from the contract bid price obtained under
- 22 subsection (b) or by providing AEDs obtained under subsection
- 23 <u>(b)</u>.
- 24 (f) The purchase of AEDs shall be considered an allowable
- 25 <u>use of Pennsylvania Accountability Grants under section</u>
- 26 2599.2(b).
- 27 (q) The purchase of AEDs shall be considered an innovative
- 28 educational program under Article XX-B.
- 29 (h) The purchase of AEDs shall be considered an eligible
- 30 school safety and security expense in section 1306-B(j).

- 1 (i) The department may accept donations, including donations
- 2 of equipment, for use in providing CPR and AED instruction to
- 3 students, employes and volunteers at school entities, nonpublic
- 4 schools and private schools. The following apply:
- 5 (1) The department shall geographically distribute any
- 6 <u>donations to school entities</u>, nonpublic schools and private
- 7 schools for the purpose of CPR and AED instruction under section
- 8 1423.1.
- 9 (2) A school entity, nonpublic school or private school may
- 10 accept from the department donations received under this
- 11 <u>subsection for use in providing instruction to students, school</u>
- 12 <u>employes and volunteers in the principles and techniques of CPR</u>
- 13 and operating an AED. A school entity, nonpublic school or
- 14 private school may accept other donations, including donations
- 15 of equipment, for use in providing the instruction.
- 16 (3) To the extent that resources are available to a school
- 17 entity, nonpublic school or private school under this section,
- 18 the school entity, nonpublic school or private school may make
- 19 available instruction to students in the principles and
- 20 techniques of CPR and operating an AED.
- 21 (4) A school entity, nonpublic school or private school may
- 22 use resources other than those made available under this section
- 23 to make available instruction to students, school employes and
- 24 volunteers in the principles and techniques of CPR and operating
- 25 an AED.
- 26 (j) The department may adopt quidelines as necessary to
- 27 <u>administer this section</u>.
- 28 (k) The General Assembly may appropriate money to carry out
- 29 the provisions of this section.
- 30 (1) As used in this section, the following words and phrases

- 1 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 2 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 3 "Automated external defibrillator" or "AED" means as defined
- 4 <u>in section 1423.1.</u>
- 5 <u>"CPR" means cardiopulmonary resuscitation.</u>
- 6 "Department" means as defined in section 1423.1.
- 7 "Nonpublic school" means as defined in section 1423.1.
- 8 "Private school" means as defined in section 1423.1.
- 9 "Program" means the Automated External Defibrillator Program
- 10 <u>established under this section.</u>
- 11 "School building" means a building owned by or under the
- 12 control of a school entity, nonpublic school or private school
- 13 where classes are taught or extracurricular activities are
- 14 <u>conducted on a regular basis.</u>
- 15 "School entity" means as defined in section 1423.1.
- 16 Section 1423.3. Availability and Specifications of Automated
- 17 External Defibrillators. -- (a) Each school entity, nonpublic
- 18 school and private school shall have at least one automated
- 19 <u>external defibrillator in each school building of the school</u>
- 20 <u>entity</u>, <u>nonpublic school or private school at all times during</u>
- 21 the school day.
- 22 (b) Each school entity, nonpublic school or private school
- 23 shall make available an AED and at least one employe of the
- 24 school entity, nonpublic school or private school who is trained
- 25 and certified under section 1423.1 at each athletic activity.
- 26 The presence of emergency services personnel shall fulfill this
- 27 requirement.
- 28 (b.1) The Department of Education, in consultation with the
- 29 Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association, shall develop
- 30 guidelines for the availability of AEDs at athletic activities

- 1 which shall specify that an AED need not be physically present
- 2 <u>in the immediate vicinity of every ongoing athletic activity,</u>
- 3 but must be readily available and accessible at the location of
- 4 the athletic activity.
- 5 <u>(c) This section does not:</u>
- 6 (1) waive any liability or immunity of a school entity,
- 7 nonpublic school or private school or its officers or employes;
- 8 or
- 9 (2) create any liability for or a cause of action against a
- 10 <u>school entity</u>, <u>nonpublic school or private school or its</u>
- 11 <u>officers or employes.</u>
- 12 (d) The provisions of 42 Pa.C.S. § 8331.2 (relating to good
- 13 <u>Samaritan civil immunity for use of automated external</u>
- 14 <u>defibrillator</u>) shall apply to school entity, nonpublic school or
- 15 private school employes who render care with an AED.
- 16 <u>(e) Each school entity, nonpublic school and private school</u>
- 17 shall ensure that each AED on the premises of the school entity,
- 18 nonpublic school or private school is properly tested and
- 19 maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's operational
- 20 guidelines. Each AED in a school entity, nonpublic school or
- 21 private school shall meet the most recent minimum specifications
- 22 as required by the Department of Health.
- 23 (f) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 24 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 25 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 26 "Athletic activity" means as defined in section 1425(h).
- 27 "Automated external defibrillator" or "AED" means as defined
- 28 in section 1423.1.
- 29 "Emergency services personnel" means any of the following:
- 30 (1) An emergency medical responder.

- 1 (2) An emergency medical technician.
- 2 (3) An advanced emergency medical technician.
- 3 <u>(4) A paramedic.</u>
- 4 (5) A prehospital registered nurse.
- 5 <u>(6) A prehospital physician extender.</u>
- 6 (7) A prehospital emergency medical services physician.
- 7 (8) An individual prescribed by regulations of the
- 8 Department of Health to provide specialized emergency medical
- 9 services.
- 10 "Nonpublic school" means as defined in section 1423.1.
- "Private school" means as defined in section 1423.1.
- "School building" means as defined in section 1423.1.
- "School day" means as defined in section 1423.1.
- "School entity" means as defined in section 1423.1.
- 15 Section 1426. Sudden Cardiac Event Emergency Action Plan for <--
- 16 Athletic Activities. (a) Beginning with the 2023-2024 school
- 17 year, each school entity and nonpublic school shall establish
- 18 and implement a sudden cardiac event emergency action plan for
- 19 responding to a sudden cardiac event at an athletic activity,
- 20 including an event in which the use of an automated external
- 21 defibrillator may be necessary. The plan shall be consistent
- 22 with the provisions of section 1423 and include the following,
- 23 at a minimum:
- 24 (1) A cardiac emergency response team list, comprised of
- 25 <u>individuals who have current cardiopulmonary</u>
- 26 resuscitation/automated external defibrillator certification.
- 27 The list shall include school nurses, coaches and at least five
- 28 other full-time school personnel. The list shall be updated once
- 29 <u>a year.</u>
- 30 (2) Detailed procedures on responding to a sudden cardiac

- 1 event which shall include the identification of school personnel-
- 2 who shall be responsible for all of the following:
- 3 (i) Responding to an individual experiencing a sudden
- 4 cardiac event.
- 5 (ii) Contacting 911 and providing a copy of the plan to
- 6 local emergency response and dispatch agencies and assisting
- 7 emergency responders in reaching the individual experiencing a
- 8 sudden cardiac event.
- 9 <u>(iii) Starting cardiopulmonary resuscitation.</u>
- 10 (iv) Retrieving and using the automated external
- 11 <u>defibrillator</u>.
- 12 (v) Placement and maintenance of automated external
- 13 defibrillators, including the recommended number of automated
- 14 external defibrillators inside a school building, outside a
- 15 <u>school building and backups that shall be held in reserve for</u>
- 16 <u>use as replacements for an automated external defibrillator</u>
- 17 which may be out-of-service.
- 18 (vi) Conducting an annual review and evaluation of the plan,
- 19 including comparing the plan to updated recommendations from the
- 20 American Heart Association. The annual review and evaluation
- 21 shall be conducted by the school entity's or nonpublic school's
- 22 administrative staff.
- 23 (b) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 24 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 25 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 26 "Automated external defibrillator" means a portable device
- 27 that uses electric shock to restore a stable heart rhythm to an
- 28 individual in cardiac arrest.
- 29 "Nonpublic school" means a nonprofit school, other than a
- 30 public school within this Commonwealth, wherein a resident of

- 1 this Commonwealth may legally fulfill the compulsory school
- 2 attendance requirements of this act and which meets the
- 3 applicable requirements of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of
- 4 1964 (Public Law 88-352, 78 Stat. 241).
- 5 "School entity" means an area career and technical school, a
- 6 charter school, a cyber charter school, an intermediate unit or
- 7 a school district.
- 8 Section 3. School entities, nonpublic schools and private
- 9 schools shall comply with the addition of sections 1423.1,
- 10 1423.2, 1423.3 and 1426 AND 1423.3 of the act no later than
- 11 three years after the effective date of this section.
- 12 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
