1 2 3	Amending Title 67 (Public Welfare) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in human services generally, providing for autism screening.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:

13	<u>§ 4101. Definitions.</u>
14	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
15	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
16	context clearly indicates otherwise:
17	"Licensed child-care provider." A premises licensed under_

1	55 Pa. Code Ch. 20 (relating to licensure or approval of
2	facilities and agencies) and operating under the requirements of
3	55 Pa. Code Ch. 3270 (relating to child day care centers) that
4	provides care at any one time for seven or more minors unrelated
5	to the operator.
6	<u>§ 4102. Autism screening.</u>
7	<u>The department shall:</u>
8	(1) Develop an autism screening tool that may be used by
9	a licensed child-care provider in this Commonwealth to screen
10	children who are 18 months of age, 24 months of age and 36
11	months of age in the licensed child-care provider's care for
12	autism.
13	(2) Provide training for the autism screening tool free
14	of charge to licensed child-care providers, including
15	protocols for appropriate follow-up with parents.
16	(3) Notify all licensed child-care providers in this
17	Commonwealth, at least annually, of the autism screening tool
18	and training and that both are provided free of charge.
19	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
