AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for 2 contributions for sexual offense evidence testing and 3 establishing the Sexual Offense Evidence Testing Account. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 1321. Contributions for sexual offense evidence testing. 10 (a) General rule. -- Within one year of the effective date of this section, the department shall provide for all of the 11 12 following: 13 (1) The ability of a person renewing a driver's license or identification card electronically through the 14 15 department's publicly accessible Internet website to make a 16 contribution for evidence testing. 17 (2) The ability of a person renewing a vehicle registration electronically through the department's publicly 18

- 3 (b) Implementation.--
- 4 (1) A contribution under subsection (a) shall be added,
- 5 as appropriate, to the regular fee for:
- 6 <u>(i) An original or renewal driver's license or</u>
- 7 identification card.
- 8 <u>(ii) A renewal vehicle registration.</u>
- 9 (2) One contribution under subsection (a) may be made
- 10 for:
- (i) Each issuance or renewal of a driver's license
- 12 <u>or identification card.</u>
- 13 <u>(ii) Each renewal vehicle registration.</u>
- (c) Use. -- Contributions under subsection (a) shall be used
- 15 <u>exclusively to assist the Pennsylvania State Police and other</u>
- 16 law enforcement agencies in testing evidence collected in
- 17 relation to a sexual assault or other sexual offense at a crime
- 18 lab approved by the Pennsylvania State Police.
- 19 (d) Deposits.--
- 20 (1) The department shall determine on a monthly basis
- 21 the total amount collected under this section and shall
- 22 report the amount to the State Treasurer.
- 23 (2) The State Treasurer shall transfer the amount
- reported under paragraph (1) from the General Fund to the
- 25 Sexual Offense Evidence Testing Account, which account is
- 26 established in the State Treasury. The money in the account
- 27 is appropriated on a continuing basis to the Pennsylvania
- 28 State Police and shall be used for evidence testing in sexual
- assault and sexual offense investigations.
- 30 (e) Information.--

- 1 (1) The department shall provide adequate information 2 concerning the contribution for testing evidence collected in relation to a sexual assault or other sexual offense at a 3 crime lab in its instructions for applicants under subsection 4 (a). The information concerning the contribution shall 5 include the listing of an address furnished by the State 6 Treasurer to which contributions may be sent by individuals 7 wishing to make additional contributions. 8 9 (2) The Pennsylvania State Police and the Attorney General shall conduct a public information campaign on the 10 availability of this opportunity to Pennsylvania taxpayers. 11
- 12 (f) Reporting. -- The Governor shall report annually to the
- 13 Judiciary Committee of the Senate and the Judiciary Committee of
- 14 the House of Representatives on the amount received from the
- 15 contributions authorized by this section and how the funds were
- 16 used.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
