8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. The act of October 5, 1978 (P.L.1109, No.261),
10	known as the Osteopathic Medical Practice Act, is amended by
11	adding a section to read:
12	Section 13.4. Disclosure of complaints filed against
13	physicians.
14	<u>A physician shall not be required to disclose a complaint</u>
15	filed against the physician with the board to any person or
16	entity if all of the following apply:
17	(1) The board determines that no disciplinary or
18	corrective action against the physician is necessary.
19	(2) The complaint file is closed without any
20	disciplinary or corrective action against the physician.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
