13	Section 1. The act of December 20, 1985 (P.L.457, No.112),
14	known as the Medical Practice Act of 1985, is amended by adding
15	a section to read:
16	Section 44.1. Disclosure of complaints filed against
17	physicians.
18	<u>A physician shall not be required to disclose a complaint</u>
19	filed against the physician with the board to any person or
20	entity if all of the following apply:
21	(1) The board determines that no disciplinary or
22	corrective action against the physician is necessary.

- 1 (2) The complaint file is closed without any
- 2 <u>disciplinary or corrective action against the physician.</u>
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
