- 2 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 3 "Department." The Department of State of the Commonwealth.
- 4 <u>"Election Day." The day of a general election or primary</u>
- 5 election.
- 6 <u>"General election." The election which the Constitution of</u>
- 7 Pennsylvania requires to be held in even-numbered years.
- 8 "Primary election." An election for the nomination of
- 9 <u>candidates.</u>
- 10 "Private employer." An employer that is engaged in business
- 11 in this Commonwealth. The term does not include a public
- 12 <u>employer</u>, school district or county.
- 13 <u>"Public employer."</u>
- 14 <u>(1) Any of the following:</u>
- 15 (i) The Commonwealth.
- 16 (ii) A political subdivision of the Commonwealth,
- including a board, commission, agency or authority of the
- 18 <u>Commonwealth.</u>
- 19 (iii) Any other instrumentality of the Commonwealth.
- 20 (2) The term does not include a school district or
- 21 county.
- 22 § 502. Observance of Election Day as legal holiday.
- 23 (a) General rule.--A public employer shall observe Election
- 24 Day as a legal holiday.
- 25 (b) Other public entities. -- A school district or county may
- 26 <u>observe Election Day as a legal holiday.</u>
- 27 <u>(c) Private employers.--</u>
- 28 (1) On Election Day, a private employer shall provide no
- less than two hours of unpaid leave to its employees for the
- 30 purpose of voting.

- 1 (2) A private employer that fails to comply with this
- 2 subsection shall pay a fine of not less than \$1,000 to the
- 3 <u>county board of elections.</u>
- 4 (d) Enforcement. -- The department shall enforce the
- 5 provisions of this section and may promulgate regulations
- 6 necessary to enforce the provisions of this section.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
