## AN ACT

1 2 3	Designating a bridge on a portion of Sheep Bridge Road over I- 83, Newberry Township, York County as the Staff Sgt. Jason M. Faley Memorial Bridge.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Staff Sgt. Jason M. Faley Memorial Bridge.
7	(a) FindingsThe General Assembly finds and declares as
8	follows:
9	(1) Staff Sergeant Jason Matthew Faley was born on May
10	19, 1973 and graduated from Red Land High School in 1991.
11	(2) He was a Staff Sergeant in the United States Air
12	Force, Special Operations Tactical Air Control Party, serving
13	with the 5th Special Forces stationed at Fort Campbell,
14	Kentucky, supporting the 101st Airborne Forces.
15	(3) Staff Sergeant Jason M. Faley was killed in Kuwait
16	on March 12, 2001.

1 (4) Prior to his death, he received numerous medals and 2 commendations including the Air Force Achievement Medal, The 3 Army Achievement Medal, the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, the Airborne Parachutist Badge, the Military Free Fall Badge, 4 5 The Air Assault Badge and the Pathfinder Badge. He was also 6 Ranger certified and a graduate of Airman Leadership School. Designation.--The bridge located on Sheep Bridge Road in 7 (b) 8 Newberry Township, York County over I-83 is hereby designated the Staff Sgt. Jason M. Faley Memorial Bridge. 9

10 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and 11 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to 12 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

13 Section 2. Effective date.

14 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
